

### The needs assessment examined









To what extent have the fewer in-person visits due to patient and family concerns about risk of COVID-19 infection challenged routine patient vaccination within your practice?







To what extent has the lack of time (e.g., for vaccine counseling and documentation the following factors challenged routine patient vaccination within your practice?






During patient counseling, how often do patients and their families have questions about…











How often do you use the following strategies when communicating with your patients about routine vaccinations?




#### 100% of respondents said they **always** present vaccines as the norm.












To what extent do you need support in addressing the following COVID-19 topics during patient counseling?

COVID-19 vaccine requirements for childcare and school




