


#### Needs Assessment Purpose


#### The needs assessment examined:




# These the six most favored questions:


- 1. My health professional provides me with all the information I need to answer my questions on immunizations. (85%)
- 2. Have you ever been hesitant about receiving a vaccine? (76%)
- 3. Has distance, timing of clinic, or wait at clinic and/or costs into getting to clinic prevented you from getting your child immunized? (76%)
- 4. Do you feel you get enough information about vaccines and their safety? (75%)
- 5. Have you seen/read/heard something in social media that made you re-consider choice to have your child vaccinated? (71%)
- 6. Who do you trust the most for medical information? (67%)





Has distance, timing of clinic, or wait at clinic and/or costs in getting to clinic prevented you from getting your child immunized?





Do you feel you get enough information about vaccines and their safety?




### Understanding Medical Information Sources










### Understanding Community Needs

Has your community in the past refused to accept certain vaccines? Which vaccine(s) and why?




# Understanding Attitudes about Vaccine Requirements

The only reason I have my child get shots is so that they can enter daycare, school or sports. Yes/No




# Understanding Attitudes about Vaccine Requirements


Does your child's daycare/school require/advise to have your child vaccinated? Do you agree?



I agree that it is important for everyone to get the recommended vaccines for themselves and their children.




Do you think it's important to get a vaccine to protect those that cannot get vaccinated?




Would the cost of a vaccine prevent you from getting it, even if you felt you or your child needed it?




How concerned are you that your child might have a serious side effect from a shot?




Do you believe that if you vaccinate your child, others are protected as well?




Do you believe vaccines are safe for yourself/your child/children? For those in your community?

- "If your child is/was not vaccinated according to the recommended vaccine schedule, what was your main reason? multiple choice with answers like: too many vaccines at once, child too young, fear of adverse reaction, lack of access to care, etc."

- "Has the push for the COVID vaccine made you question the safety or efficacy of other vaccines? If yes, why?"

- "Why would you refrain from having your child vaccinate? A.) religious exempt, B.) Medical Exemption, C) need further education, D) do not believe in the vaccine E) distrust the information provided."

- "As a follow up question to cost being prohibitive to getting their child vaccinated, I think asking parents if they're aware their child can receive no or low-cost vaccines at some providers through the Vaccines for Children program."
