# **DELIVERANCE MINISTRY (JESUS IS THE DELIVERER)**

#### Mark 1:21 Read this account

- -Man was in synagogue (believer and worshipper)
- -Man with a demon (unclean spirit, evil spirit)
- -Demon was in the man and spoke through him (needed a body to express itself)
- -Demons knew who Jesus was they know his authority
- -Jesus commanded the demon out and said "be silent and come out of him"
- -People asked "what new teaching is this?" Jesus proclaimed the Kingdom of God is here (rule & reign)

Mark 1:14-15 Good News of Kingdom of God "Satans rule over humanity is over

Matthew 12:28 "If I cast out a demon by the Spirit of God then the Kingdom of God has come upon you" Deliverance is a demonstration of the Kingdom

-Jesus fame spread everywhere because of it (he was known as the deliverer)

JESUS is the same yesterday, today, and forever Hebrews 13:8

#### SAME HUMANS - SAME DEMONS - SAME JESUS

Has Jesus changes of has the church changed?

#### MY TESTIMONY OF DELIVERANCE

What is deliverance? A spirit is driven out (cast out) of a person which leads to freedom. Just as God saved the people of Israel from their physical enemies (flesh & blood), God saves us from our spiritual enemies (demonic spirits)

Jesus name means "Lord is salvation" Greek word for salvation "sozo" means to save, healing, deliverance, rescue, wholeness, made well, cured

# A big question that needs to be answered is "Can a Christian have a demon?"

- 2 things need to be understood here:
  - a. What happens at salvation?
  - b. What it means to be possessed by a demon?

# SALVATION IS IN THREE LEVELS

## MAN IS 3 PART BEING (BODY -SOUL-SPIRIT)

The **spirit** is perfect 100 % saved and ready for heaven. At Salvation the spirit of a person is made new (made to come alive) 2 Cor 5:17. Demons are not in a person spirit as this is where Holy Spirit resides. 1 Cor 6:17 "Bur he who is joined to the Lord is on e spirit"

**Soul** is not made new and is being saved as a process of growth, sanctification and renewing of the mind. The soul includes the mind, the will, thinking, emotions, imagination, and intellect. etc

Ex. Luke 8:35 man was found in his right mind meaning he was not in his right mind prior, 2 Tim 1:7 "God has not given us a spirit of fear"

Body is not made new-cells, limbs, internal parts and organs

Ex. Luke 13:11,16 woman who was bent over from a spirit states that "Satan had bound her for 18 yrs"

Luke 11:14-boy who had a mute spirit. Spirit was cast out and the boy spoke

Question is, what was creating both of these mental and physical ailments?

Another scripture used incorrectly- 2 Cor 6:14 "what fellowship has light with darkness? Contrast in motivations between believers and unbelievers . Jesus or Devil

## Another question is "What it means to be possessed by a demon?"

Greek word translated "demon possessed" is daimonizomai

It does not mean owned by demons or the devil-Jesus owns us as He "purchased us with His own blood" Acts 20:28

"Daimonizomai" means - In grip of, to have a demon, to be under influence or power of a demon, or "demonized"

Whatever area of a person's life has not come under Lordship and control of Holy Spirit can be influenced by a demon

#### What are demons?

They are persons without bodies. They are disembodied spirits that have no flesh and blood (physical body). They crave expression and ideally want to attach to a human body to push their agenda through it. Ex. A spirit of anger needs a body to express anger through it. A spirit of sexual perversion needs a body to express sexual perverse acts through it.

Why do we need to know about demons? We need to know our enemy. Sun Tzu who was a great military general wrote a famous book about strategy of war called "Art of War" He said in his book that "if you know the enemy and know yourself, you need not fear the result of a hundred battles. If you know yourself but not the enemy, for every victory gained you will also suffer a defeat."

- Ignorance of demons is rampant in churches
- Demons actually create doubt, skepticism, and fear about themselves to remain hidden
- Jesus was neither ignorant nor fanatical about demons. When he came face to face with them, He dealt with them in truth (reality). Jesus calls us to do the same as his disciples

Is it flesh or demons? Remedy for each is different. This issue needs discernment

Can't cast out flesh (discipline is needed)

Can't crucify demons (deliverance is needed)

3 main ways demons get in (inheritance, what was done to you (being sinned against), what we have done (our own sin)

#### How Demons get in: (Open doors or legal rights)

## 1. Generational sin (curses)- (Exodus 20:5)

Every person has a spiritual DNA. Sinful patterns are passed down the bloodline. Generational iniquities are a bent or magnet towards sin. Demons enforce these patterns (curses).

## 2. Occult/False Religion (Deuteronomy 18:10-13)

Occult means hidden or concealed. Involvement with mediums, fortune telling, talking to the dead. Partnering with demons to get power and/or knowledge. False god worship (idols)

#### 3. Trauma (being sinned against)

Most demons enter in through childhood when people are most vulnerable and impressionable. It is not so much what happened but more so the persons reactions to what happened to them which opens doors: Abuse, negative words spoken, rape, rejection, abandonment, anger, fear, self hatred, etc

## 4. Sinful practices (Ephesians 4:19-21, 26-27)

Yielding to sinful practices (flesh) will open doors to demons. Sin opens doors to demons. Sexual immorality, drug use, uncontrollable anger, etc

## 5. Sickness/Infirmity (Matthew 9:32-33, Luke 13:11-13)

A spirit can cause almost any kind of infirmity or sickness in the body.

## How to get demons out (deliverance)

Deliverance is the driving out or expelling of a demonic spirit from a person.

Cast out "ekballo" means to drive out, to cast out, expel

Authority in the name of Jesus (Luke 10:19). We are given this authority as a disciple of Jesus.

Jesus said if He casts out a demon by the finger of God the kingdom has come upon you. (Luke 13:11) Deliverance is putting the enemy under your feet.

The Holy Spirit has all power and knows all things so partnering with Him is the best way to operate in the ministry of deliverance.

## Deliverance is not a formula but here are some basic principles.

- 1. Confession and repentance of sin. Acknowledge the sin that opened the door(s). This could be own sin and/or generational sin.
- 2. Forgive all people who have hurt you. Forgiveness is a decision and not a feeling.
- 3. Pray that the Holy Spirit touch all the "broken parts" of the person. This can be referred to as "inner healing"
- 4. Renounce all sin that opened the doors. Renounce means to "break ties or partnership with"
- 5. Cast out demons. Take authority over demons and command them to leave.
- 6. The Holy Spirit will show you how to do deliverance and always be led by Him.
- 7. Pray that the person be filled with the Holy Spirit after deliverance. This could be the "Baptism in Holy Spirit" for the first time or a refilling of the Holy Spirit.

Manifestations (what happens when a spirit leaves the body) common ones are: shaking, coughing, crying, shaking, spitting up, vomiting, screaming, convulsing, contortions, etc.

Don't make anything happen but don't fight against something happening. "You can have your dignity or have your deliverance, both you can't have both" Derek Prince

#### **Deliverance Aftercare**

- 1. You must fill yourself with Jesus and an opposite lifestyle from which the person was delivered from. Jesus said "Go and sin no more" Live a holy life. Submit your life to God and come under spiritual authority in relationship with other like minded believers.
- 2. Live by Gods Word. In Matthew 4:4 Jesus said that mankind shall live by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God" The word *live* is all inclusive, covering everything we think, say or do. All must proceed from the same source: the Word of God. We must learn and study the Word of God (Bible). Think the Word of God, speak the Word of God, act the Word of God.
- 3. Be a person of prayer. Prayer is relationship with God. Prayer is not a monologue but is a dialogue. We talk to God but we also need to listen to God to hear what He has to say to us. In John 10:27 Jesus says "my sheep hear my voice"
- 4. Learn to be a person of praise and worship. Worshipping God is a lifestyle of a disciple of Jesus Christ. God is looking for people who worship in "Spirit and in truth" John 4:24
- 5. Renewing of the mind is the process of transformation. Romans 12:2. We must learn to think differently which helps us live differently. Spend time with like minded people.

We are all called to participate in the Great Commission- We are all commissioned by Jesus to go out. He has given us power and authority to accomplish the mission.

Matthew 10:1 - Jesus gives his 12 disciples power over demons and sends them out.

**Luke 10: 1-** Jesus appointed the 70 and sent them out. In **Luke 10:19** Jesus said, "I've given you power to trample on serpents and scorpions" The disciples said in **Luke 10:17** "Lord, even the demons are subject to us through your name" Jesus said, "Do not rejoice in this that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice that your names are written in heaven (salvation)"

Acts 8: 5-8 Philip Preached Christ (Gospel), cast out demons, healed the sick. This account was after Jesus ascended back to heaven and the Holy Spirit was poured out at Day of Pentecost.

Mark 16: 15-17- Jesus sends the entire church into the world, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.... And these signs will follow those that believe, In my name they will cast out demons

Jesus sent 100% of the 12, and 100% of the 70, and 100% of His church to do the ministry of casting out demons. Who He calls, He equips.
