86CANCER OILERS EXPERIENCE FOR LAKELAND ALBERTA RESIDENT CANCER PATIENTS APPLICATION FORM

The 86Cancer Oilers Experience was designed to support Lakeland cancer patients by offering a temporary escape from the challenges of their battle. This program provides applicants with a chance to enjoy an important distraction and create positive memories during an otherwise difficult time. Each experience includes up to five Oilers tickets per family, along with limited financial assistance for hotel accommodations, meals, and gas. The initiative supports up to five families, ensuring they can take a break from their struggles and experience the joy of an NHL hockey game.

Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant must be diagnosed with cancer. Priority given to those in active treatment (surgery, chemotherapy and radiation) or 6 months post-treatment.
- The applicant must be a Canadian citizen and reside within the Lakeland Alberta geographic area.
- Only one application accepted per family.
- Priority given to affected families that include minor children.
- The application must be signed by a friend or family member as a guarantor that can confirm details of the application.

Required Documents

- Letter of intent written by the applicant or nominator explaining their situation in detail, this will be used by our selection team and will be kept confidential.
- Applications need to be submitted by March 8th, 2026.

Further Details

- Applicant must be available to attend the selected game date of March 31st, 2026. Tickets are non-transferrable and non-refundable. Tickets cannot be sold for monetary value.
- Cost of gas, food and accommodations will be covered by gift cards of a specific amount.
- 86Cancer is not responsible for any accidents, injuries, damages or theft that may occur throughout the event including transportation to and from.
- In the unfortunate event that the applicant can no longer attend the event, tickets will not be reimbursed for monetary value and forfeited for redistribution.
- Applicant will be selected and notified by March 13th, 2026, via phone and/or email. Chosen applicants agree to have their experience and photos taken during the event shared via social media. Personal details and information submitted will remain confidential.
