Here are a few tips that may help you through this Discipleship journey:

1. Ask Holy Spirit to help you find a specific day and time to meet with Him and complete each study.
2. Sometimes one study per week can be a fun journey; however, it depends on how God leads you in terms of timing/completion.
3. Write out each numbered question as to what you think the Holy Spirit is speaking to you about that specific Bible passage.
 - a. For Example, I read John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son; that whosoever believe in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life." I just pray quickly and ask God to help me hear what He is speaking and maybe I write: "It's WHOEVER that God may call; it is the entire world! Wow! Thank you, Lord, for helping me finally hear your call of salvation."
4. The next section is the application section. This is where you ask God to help work it into your soul, like a healing balm. There is also a question to follow up with someone who lives near you, to meet with them. Possibly your Pastor or Sunday school teacher.
5. Some sections (especially in Module 2) will have thoughts and prayers. We attempted to leave the first module free from any guided prayer and thoughts; so that way it's simply you and God. You allow God to speak to you through His word. It's very powerful that way, it will be His words in your heart.
6. In section two I did provide some extra thoughts as though we were meeting together. I did this mostly for those who have a religious background. Sometimes denominational glasses can create roadblocks to God's simple word.
7. Finally, a section is provided for you to write down your favorite Bible passages to be memorized. As well, a grid is included for you to write out those Bible passages and cut them out to take along with you for review during each day of life's journey.
8. The first module should take 30 minutes to an hour. The second module may take 1 hour to 1.5 hours. It's a big step up in commitment but in this new age and dark era we live in God spoke to my heart so strongly, "son, you have to start equipping my newborn babies with spiritual warfare very early on in their walk now." I said, "Ok Lord."

Insights into the Holy Spirit and Fire Bible study

In Mark 16 I stayed so confused for many years with Jesus and God's word. Especially in Mark 16: ¹⁹*After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God.* ²⁰*Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.*

How could Jesus, "continue to work with them, confirming his word by signs and miracles that accompanied?" The Passion Translation translates that portion of the Aramaic, "they preached with miracle-signs that accompanied them."

Jesus was the needed sacrifice so that God's plan could unfold. As Simon Peter said in Acts 2, "so that the fulfillment of Joel 2 could take place...in the last days I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh." Holy Spirit would no longer be confined to the Holy of Holies in the inner sanctum of the Jewish Tabernacle. We see His fire dwelling on top of there by night, and His cloud by day. Now, God would fulfill His promise that one day that same presence of the Holy Spirit would occupy man's heart and life. O God, consume us and have mercy on us by the precious blood of Jesus. May we burn for you and with you Jesus. Set our hearts ablaze. Now we know how the transaction of Mark 16 takes place upon the earth; with Jesus continuing to work in coordination with them! By His Spirit.

I love that scene in the recently (2020-2022) released, "The Chosen." Jesus and two of the disciples are bunking in the same room while resting from traveling on the road. When they awoke in the morning Jesus was smiling. One of the disciples smiled and said, "did the lamb man walk this morning that you prayed for last night?" Jesus grinned big and nodded yes. The disciple was amazed. Jesus then looked at him and said, "Just wait till you do it!" His response was hilarious and amazing. A look met with shock. The disciple was more than eager to start asking lots of questions. Jesus gently stopped him and said, "that is for a later time."

I find this true, especially about this area of the Holy Spirit and his giftings we will soon study. Jesus seems to open this curtain a little at a time, slowly. (But not always, just seems most of the time) Just like that scene in, "The Chosen," the disciples had many life lessons to learn in their new walk with Jesus. Most of all like any other relationship

Jesus wanted to build closeness with them, slowly releasing trust with His power. Not that it was "their power," but He

would be trusting them as a Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of a company would eventually trust the new secretary of the corporation with increased responsibilities to act on his behalf.

Jesus loves you as you will never be loved, it's my prayer the Bible studies we conducted in Module 1 on Assurance of our relationship with Jesus will keep your heart and mind grounded in His truth to never abandon you. It's at this point that trust, and cooperation converge. Jesus, like any other relationship, entrusts us with responsibilities to represent Him and His Kingdom on behalf of His Father. We truly are in the making of becoming, "Ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us." (2 Corinthians 5:20) This is a process, just like training in the military. The young recruit begins at ground zero and grows into his new assignment from basic training.

One of the great keys to staying on this path and remaining consistent in our training is the decision to, "Take up our cross and follow Him." (Luke 9:23) The daily walk of Matthew 4:19-21, "Come follow Me Jesus said, "and I will MAKE you (Fashion you, form you, mold you) into fishers of men." It's as simple as taking a humble paying job and being a consistent worker full of love for fellow employees daily. Being a good husband, and wife that our spouse needs us to be. Loving with no return. Forgiving where there has been hurt and offense. Selecting relationships that are God ordained versus self-ordained. Following God's will for a job and career. Not reviling when reviled.

That is hard, especially in this anti-Christ era where so many seem to be full of hate and anger. How do we keep the world out of us? In this age keeping the world out of us is more important than at any time in history.

So how do we? I love that old song, "I'm falling in love with Jesus." A daily love walks with God, asking Jesus to reveal Himself to us through His Holy Spirit. Talking to the Holy Spirit, inviting Him in, telling Holy Spirit we love Him and need Him.

(Holy Spirit and Fire Bible study)

"Lord, dip me in the kerosene of thy Holy Spirit and set my heart ablaze that I may burn for you." (William J Seymour, Revivalist of the Asuza Street Revival). Asking the Holy Spirit to lead us daily through fresh times of repenting of our sins; not in a condemning way but in a loving way. Like a daily shower. Trusting God to help us make the right decision the following day. Asking Holy Spirit to wash us with the blood of Jesus.

Prayer:

And now, my prayer for you and I are; "Lord, dip us in the kerosene of thy Holy Spirit and set my heart ablaze that I may burn for you." May you burn for Jesus. May Holy Spirit set you ablaze in Himself even now. Will you raise your hands towards heaven and pray this prayer as God sends Angels into your room to lay hands on you?

"Father, in the precious name of Jesus, by His blood and declaring Jesus did indeed rise in the flesh and is the only way to God, I ask you Father to baptize me, electrocute me, douse me with the kerosene of thy Holy Spirit, lay hands on me Father just like Acts 19:1-6; I drop all nets in my life, I give you 100% of the pie of my life, not 99%, but every piece of my life pie now belongs to you Jesus. I submit my mind, WILL, and emotions to you; I submit my career, my spouse (future spouse), finances, and education, my everything in life is your Jesus, and now engulf me with the Holy Ghost (as King James says), I receive you now Holy Spirit of Jesus, fill every ounce of me. Holy Spirit, I invite you into the secret areas of my heart, those closed rooms, the rooms of my heart that have trauma, hurt, and addiction. I'm so sorry for clinging to these areas or secret rooms Lord. Please forgive me, Jesus. I invite you in now, seal me now Holy Spirit and fill me with you so I will not be filled with this world. I lift my arms straight to heaven and receive the gift of your precious Holy Spirit, "with evidence of speaking in tongues and prophecy. I surrender to you Father, in Jesus' name. I yield to you Holy Spirit." (Just sit, or kneel, or stand real still, let the quiet space around you be electrified by the Holy Spirit. Watch His Holy Fire consume every molecule in the air around you. "Take off thine shoes Moses, for you are standing on Holy ground."

It's one thing to study about the Holy Spirit. Accepting the baptism of the Holy Spirit and baptism of holy fire unlocks the remainder of the Bible. I never truly understood most of the Bible, a good one-fourth of it especially that relates to the Holy Spirit. I knew Jesus, was saved, and knew I had a type of evangelism gift with a hunger to reach unreached people groups. But much of the Bible had a veil over it; until this day of baptism by fire converged. How glorious; how grateful to God I am for His gift of the Holy Spirit. Revelation on: Anointing – Endued with power from on high

This is a vitally important Bible study. The world or era we currently live in especially in the United States of America is now a spiritually charged battleground. The satanic Church has grown with shocking numbers over the last several years. There is NO power in heaven or on earth greater than the power of anointing through the Holy Spirit of God. The precious Blood of Jesus made this Holy Spirit baptism possible. Even in Romans 8, Paul says, “That same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead, NOW LIVES in YOU.” My God that is powerful!

Meditate on that truth, memorize that Bible passage. When we receive the Holy Spirit God Almighty is essentially placing His hands on us, through the power of Jesus, and anointing us with oil from heaven. Psalm 92:10 talks about, “I shall be anointed with Fresh oil.” That is why the Biblical practice of the laying on of hands, by an ordained man or woman of God, who is also walking in sexual and character purity (pure motives), is so vital. The goal here is to give us a heads up about the need of laying on of hands and know who is laying hands on you! It’s imperative today. We will discuss more of this in the Spiritual warfare study. So the goal here is to illustrate the Biblical model and blessing of the anointing of the oil of the Holy Spirit, and the urgency to be cautious about whom you and I allow laying hands on us. Yes, with growth, training, and even ordination you too can do that.

The focus should never be on our hands or on lifting a minister to superstar status. It’s all about motives. Only God can know mine and your motives. Just pray and ask God to protect you and lead you to someone who has a pure heart for God. This is one of the many reasons it’s imperative to find a good Spirit-filled Church led by a healthy leader who is delivered from the spirit of Narcissism/Jezebel.

Revelation on Intercessory Prayer:

What an honor, to be invited by God Almighty to partner with Him, “pulling down strongholds.”

Start low; go small and watch for quick results. Could be a problem with a co-worker. Could be a family relationship. As you grow in an intimate, personal relationship with Jesus, getting to know God; walking with Jesus Christ daily, and growing in Him, He will increase your area and authority of responsibility, perhaps even like that of Elijah! Just be aware the Jezebel size demon attacks grow with the size of your victory!

One day God will use you as well to re-arrange nations. At the time of this writing, this office of an intercessor is needed more than ever. It’s the least glorified, non-public, no-recognition office in Christianity, but includes the most awe-struck specific results that will leave you on your face as well (like Elijah) glorifying God. There may be great victories that you know God used you to partner with Him in prayer to pull down. Just a word of caution. With social media posts/video’s so prevalent, many intercessors are seeing this area diminish in their own lives in exchange for notoriety and popularity, perhaps even money! How sad.

Our human, “ego,” thirsts to be seen and recognized. Especially in this area. You will see things that astound your mind and bring tears to your eyes. Allow God to meet that human need of recognition through Him and Him alone, you can ask Him to do so.

But on a deeper level, God will bring you and me across that Jordan River, to the land of milk and honey, the land of promise. The great land of, “The Kingdom of God,” is the supernatural realm where we see strongholds torn down by God and His power. He too will touch the cracks and wounds in the “psyche,” of our foundation that thirsts for recognition resulting from childhood wounds. Jesus will counsel us in Psalm 32:8 so that the landslide breakthroughs and deliverance we will witness are about God, and not about us. That too is a growing process of God’s saving grace, flowing down from a bloody cross that delivers us from childhood scars as we grow in the office of prayer intercessors. Praise God! May Holy Spirit touch the core of your spirit even now as you touch this page. Thank you Jesus for those nail-scarred hands that are moving even now across our wounds. “By His stripes, ye are healed!” (1 Peter 2:24)

Because of that, God WILL INDEED send you across the paths of many who are in desperate need of a sheer miracle. Whether sickness, relational, or even legal, you will see the hand of God turn the affairs of mankind; perhaps even alter several severe storms that we have seen in India, Africa, and several other nations around the world. It leaves me in amazement but to my shame (forgiven but a life lesson in need of testifying to) God, thank you for your gracious mercy at the very expense of the precious blood of Jesus. Amen
