

# SP Pastoral

## Demonstration Day Biosecurity Plan

---

### 1. Purpose

SP Pastoral operates working cattle properties. This Biosecurity Plan outlines the **practical, proportionate measures** in place for demonstration days, site visits, and industry inspections.

The objective is to:

- Protect livestock health and welfare
- Maintain biosecurity integrity
- Enable safe, effective demonstrations
- Ensure visitors understand and respect operational boundaries

This plan is designed to manage **real risk**, not create unnecessary barriers to engagement.

### **Site Connectivity:**

Wi-Fi coverage is available at the property entry gate to allow visitors to complete registration or review site guidance if required.

---

### **3. Scope**

This protocol applies to:

- Demonstration days
- Industry and technical visits
- Council and stakeholder inspections
- Agricultural show follow-up visits

This protocol **does not apply** to:

- General accommodation guests
  - Non-operational areas
  - Public viewing areas not associated with livestock handling
- 

### **4. Core Biosecurity Principles**

SP Pastoral applies a **risk-based biosecurity approach**, including:

- Controls are proportionate to risk
  - Higher controls apply to livestock handling areas
  - Lower controls apply to general viewing and demonstration zones
  - Livestock movements and handling remain the primary focus of biosecurity management
- 

### **5. Visitor Confirmation (Pre-Arrival)**

All visitors attending demonstrations or site visits are required to complete the **Demo Visit Confirmation & Biosecurity Acknowledgement** prior to arrival.

By submitting the form, visitors confirm that they:

- Understand this is a working cattle property
- Will follow staff directions at all times
- Will respect signage and restricted areas
- Have declared whether they have visited another cattle property on the same day

This confirmation forms part of SP Pastoral's visitor management record.

Demonstration Site Visitor Flow



### PRE-ARRIVAL REGISTRATION

- Register online & confirm biosecurity rules
- Receive map, parking & guidance via email



### PROPERTY ENTRY

- Enter at main gate
- Follow biosecurity signage



### VISITOR PARKING

- Park in designated area
- No vehicle access beyond parking



### ORIENTATION POINT

- Orientation briefing by staff
- Follow signage & staff instructions



### DEMONSTRATION AREAS

- Access designated viewing areas only
- Restricted areas clearly marked



### EXIT

- Return to parking area
- Exit via entry driveway

Please remain in designated areas, follow signage & staff instructions.

## 6. Visitor Requirements (On Arrival)

Visitors are requested to:

- Arrive in clean footwear
- Follow all on-site signage and staff instructions
- Remain within designated visitor and demonstration areas
- Avoid entering livestock handling areas unless specifically directed


Visitors who have visited another cattle property on the same day may be subject to **additional access restrictions** at staff discretion.

---

## 7. On-Site Biosecurity Controls

### 7.1 Footwear

- Boot brushes and disinfectant spray are provided at yard entry points
- Use is **encouraged, not enforced**
- Entry to livestock handling areas may be restricted based on assessed risk



### 7.2 Movement Restrictions

- Visitors must remain in designated demonstration and viewing areas
- No access to:
  - cattle races
  - forcing pens
  - loading ramps
  - crushesunless approved and supervised by staff
- Children must be supervised at all times

### 7.3 Vehicles

- Visitor vehicles are restricted to **designated visitor parking areas only**
- No paddock, laneway, or livestock-area driving
- Contractor and operational vehicles operate under separate internal protocols





## 8. Livestock Biosecurity (SP Pastoral Operational Controls)

Independent of visitor activity, SP Pastoral maintains higher-level livestock biosecurity controls, including:

- NLIS identification and movement recording
- Known-source cattle only
- Controlled inter-farm movements
- Internal livestock transport protocols (where applicable)
- No commingling with unknown livestock

These measures operate continuously and are **not reliant on visitor compliance**.

## 9. Signage and Physical Controls

Biosecurity and visitor management signage is installed at:

- Property entry points
- Visitor parking areas
- Livestock handling zones

Signage includes:

- Biosecurity notices
- Restricted access warnings

- Visitor parking direction signs

Visitors are required to follow all posted signage.

By submitting the Demo Visit Confirmation & Biosecurity Acknowledgement form, visitors confirm that they:

- Have read and understood this Biosecurity Plan
- Agree to comply with site access restrictions
- Will follow all staff directions during their visit
