GCOS Tuesday, October 14 Meeting

Beginner's Group, 6 PM: The focus of the beginner's group is to provide education on the basic care and culture of growing orchids that are common in the hobby. The topic of our upcoming meeting is yet to be determined. Plants can be brought in to address specific questions you might have. Meeting is very casual, and questions are always welcome.

Guest Speaker, 7 pm: Leon Glicenstein About Leon:

Leon Glicenstein Ph. D. began growing orchids in 1954, and became assistant to the curator of orchids at the Brooklyn Botanic Gardens, from 1957 to 1960. He has advanced degrees in Chemistry and Horticulture, with an emphasis on plant breeding, cytology, and cytogenetics. Many GCOS members knew him when Leon worked at the Hoosier Orchid Company in Indiana starting in 1998 as a breeder as well as a grower of orchids. Leon specialized in Pleurothalidae, Zygopetalinae, Gongorinae, Angraecoid, Jewel and Painted-leaf orchids, as well as other groups. Since leaving the Hoosier Orchid Company Leon has been consulting with other orchid companies on growing orchids from seed. A strong conservationist, he has photographed native orchids in Costa Rica, California, Florida and the northwestern United States, has received many awards and published numerous articles.
