

The 2023-24 World Revolver Championship Points Series

A competitor may participate in all Point Series Matches but will only be able to use the points from two of the matches (the two highest).

The competitor will have to shoot two of the Points Series Matches and the WRC to qualify for max points.

The first-place competitor for each division will receive 100 points. All other competitors will receive points based on a percentage to how they finished to the first-place competitor. For example, if they finished 85% of the first-place competitor, they will receive 85 points.

The last Series Match of the year will be the WRC. During the WRC the competitors will receive twice the points. Whomever has the most points after the WRC and Series Matches in the division of choice, wins that division.

A competitor may earn points for all divisions in the WRCS. Before the first shot at the WRC the competitor will declare to the Match Director which division they plan on competing in for the points series. The competitor may shoot all divisions at the WRC, but only earn points in one for the points series championship. There will be a separate prize package for the WRCS winners at the WRC.

The WRCS is about getting more participation for the revolver shooting sports. I am open to using other shoots as a points series with a reasonable amount of time before the match if all five divisions can be shot in the match. These WRCS Points Series Match Rules are only for the 2023-24 WRCS. I am open to discussions on changes for how points can be obtained the 2024-25 WRCS.
