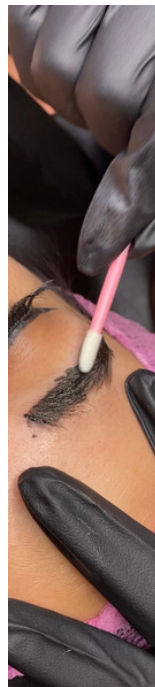

- GREET AND CONSULT (30 MIN)
- PAPERWORK
- DISCUSS AFTER CARE
- DISCUSS GOALS OF THE CLIENTS BROWS
- EXAMINE SKIN AND DECIDE ON THE TECHNIQUE (MICROBLADING, SHADING, MACHINE STROKE OR A COMBINATION)
- DRAW ON BROW STENCIL (20 MINS)
- THE CLIENT APPROVES THE DESIGN
- PERFORM THE ARTISTRY, PERMANENT MAKEUP SESSION IS 1 HOUR
- THE CLIENT APPROVES THE FINAL RESULT
- SCHEDULE A FOLLOW UP SESSION

MICROBLADING

MACHINE STROKE

- pre-shrinking tips
- 015s
- dry cotton rounds
- cotton rounds with green soap
- oil based white sharpie
- alcohol for cleaning tools

MICROSHADING

- 015s
- tip for numbing cream
- topical numbing cream
- white gel pen
- blue surgical marker
- thread

- eyebrow plastic wrap for numbing cream
- gloves
- eyebrow measure tape
- blade for eyebrow trimming
- eyebrow hair brush

DOCUMENTING YOUR WORK

The side angles, use this technique for both sides, left and right.

Tips on perspective (color coded)

- The jaw and hairline should align slightly past a 90 degree angle into a 130 degree angle. This is a flattering angle and creates a defined jaw line.

90° 130°

- This is the most important part! create straight lines with your nose and lip structure. Minimize the nostrils and don't distort the lip with a bad angle. Keep the lines parallel.

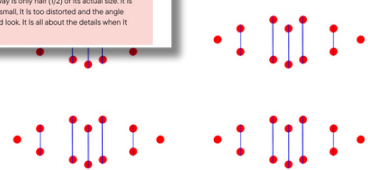
the dot exercise



purpose of this design pattern:

It is meant to create an evenly design on the lips. You are moving up to meet each point symmetrically, just draw a line from one edge to the other method creates more symmetry and balance by moving your eyes back and forth.

pattern for the outline of this lip design.



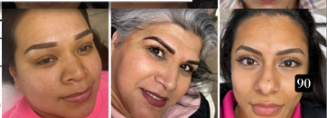
