## Replacing RBG:

In the wake of the death of Supreme Court Justice Ginsburg, President Trump says he will put forth his nominee by the end of this week. His vow to appoint a woman has many looking for who the potential nominee might be.

CNN reports, the most notable potential appointments are Amy Coney Barrett, Barbara Lagoa and Allison Jones Rushing. Barrett, who the President appointed to a seat on the 7<sup>th</sup> US Circuit Court of appeals. She is a former professor of law at her alma mater, Notre Dame. Lagoa was appointed by President Trump to the 11<sup>th</sup> US Circuit Court of Appeals in 2019. She is the first Hispanic woman and the first Cuban American to have served on the Florida Supreme Court. Rushing was appointed to the 4<sup>th</sup> US Circuit Court of Appeals since March of 2019. Most notable about Rushing is she is currently under 40 years old. If Rushing was nominated and approved, she would be one of the 4 youngest justices ever to serve the U.S. Supreme Court.

In 2016, Justice Ginsberg herself said "There's nothing in the Constitution that says the president stops being the president in his last

year" and added that the senate should not avoid confirming an appointment because "That's their job"
