

Here are some creative concepts for drawings using the Drawings Manager System:

Recurring Drawings (Daily, Weekly, Monthly)

Various options exist for setting up daily, weekly, or monthly drawings. In addition to single-winner formats, you can create drawings with payout limits, like max payout of \$500. This allows multiple winners to be chosen when the prize pool grows—for example, a \$3,000 pot with a \$500 max payout would select six members names for that drawing. Members tend to enjoy drawings more when they have multiple opportunities to win!

Dues Board Drawing

This is a favorite at many lodges. A set number of spots are offered based on the cost of membership dues—for instance, if yearly dues are \$50, there'd be 50 spots at \$1 each. Members can purchase one or more spots, and once all 50 are sold, a winner is drawn to receive a free membership renewal. It's a win-win: lodges secure early renewals, and members love the chance to get a free renewal!

Free Dues for Lunch

For lodges serving lunch, this drawing encourages members to have lunch at the lodge. Members are automatically entered when they dine in, and at the end of the month, a winner is selected for a free year of membership. It's a smart way to boost lunch traffic at the lodge as well as for the lodge to get membership renewals.

50-50 Drawing

This flexible drawing can run daily, weekly, or monthly. A winner is chosen to receive half of the collected pot, while the lodge keeps the other half—simple and effective!

Queen of Hearts / Ace of Spades / Jacks & Jokers

These popular raffle-style drawings are familiar to most lodges, though only a few run multiple versions at once. Offering more than one of these ticket-based drawings increases the odds that one will build a substantial jackpot, sparking excitement and motivating members to visit more often for a shot at a big prize.

Group-Specific Drawings (Women, Men, Veterans, etc)

These drawings are exclusive to members of designated groups, creating a smaller pool of entrants and improving the odds for those eligible. It's a great way to engage specific segments of your membership.

“Lottery” or “Pick Your Number” Drawings

Members select their preferred numbers from an available range, and if their number is drawn, they win! For example, a drawing with 999 possible numbers, a member picks one (or more) and wins if their picks match the State's Pick 3 lottery result. Alternatively, numbers from 1 to 2,000 are made available, and a random draw determines the winner. It's a fun, personalized twist!

Basket Raffles / Gun Raffles

Set up cashless drawings where winners receive prizes like a themed basket, a gun, or other items (maybe a BBQ grill or fire pit). These tangible rewards add variety and excitement to the lineup.
