



CHATV Trails Director

The Trails Director is a voting member who attends all meetings of the Board of Directors and oversees trail management on behalf of the CHATV Executive.

The Trails Director is elected at the Annual General Meeting and holds a two-year term.

The Trails Director responsibilities include but are not limited to

- Monitoring social media / club email for any reported issues on the trail
- Liasing with the President as required
- Opening and closing trails on QuadON as needed
- Creating social media posts of unsafe situations
- Liasing with OFATV Trail Manager & Staff related to Trail Rating and Trail Signage requirements, attending meetings as required
- Proposing new trails for CHATV system
- Liasing with Land owners, other ATV clubs
- Liasing with Trail Maintenance Director as needed
- Provide Reports to the CHATV Executive

Requirements:

- Candidate must hold a valid OFATV permit and / or be an affiliate club member of CHATV.

Time Commitment:

- The Board of Directors must meet a minimum of 4 times per year. Meetings have typically been held on a monthly basis, and last approximately 2 hours per meeting.
- Additional time would be required to keep up to date with OFATV trail signage and trail rating initiative and update the QuadON app.

The ideal candidate for Trails Director would:

- Have knowledge of the CHATV trail system, trail numbering and type of trail
- Have the ability to update the QuadON app
- Have demonstrated experience using social media and OFATV app's.
- Possess personal qualities of integrity, credibility, and a passion for promoting the vision of CHATV.
