Dan Lanning has the Ducks flying high in Eugene as he enters year three with an impressive 22-5 in his first two seasons. Bo Nix is gone, but no problem; Dillion Gabriel arrives in Oregon via the transfer portal from Oklahoma. Gabriel will keep this high-flying offense rolling this year with the return of Tez Johnson and the addition of Evan Stewart. The Ducks averaged 44 points last year, and with these weapons in Eugene, nothing should change for the upcoming season, which is why Gabriel is one of the shortest shots to win the Heisman. Oregon's defense will need to step up in a more physical conference. They only allowed 16 points per game last year in the PAC 12. The big game on the schedule is October 12th, when Ohio State comes to Eugene. Oregon should have one of the best teams in college football this year and I expect to see them in the College Football Playoff.

Lane Kiffin has Ole Miss heading into 2024 with a really talented roster, led by senior quarterback Jaxson Dart. The Rebels schedule also sets up really nicely for them to win 10 games and make it into the College Football Playoff, as they get Oklahoma and Georgia both at home, with their only tough road game against LSU. I could make the case that Ole Miss has the potential to run the table, but Lane Kiffin is 1-11 against Top 5 teams, so I doubt they will beat Georgia. While their ceiling is 11-1, I think their floor could be as low as 8-4. Assuming they lose to Georgia, I could see them struggling with LSU, Arkansas, or Florida on the road as well. Ultimately, the season win total is a stay-away for me, and I don't want to pay juice on them to make the College Football Playoff. But I think Ole Miss could be the second-best team in the SEC.
