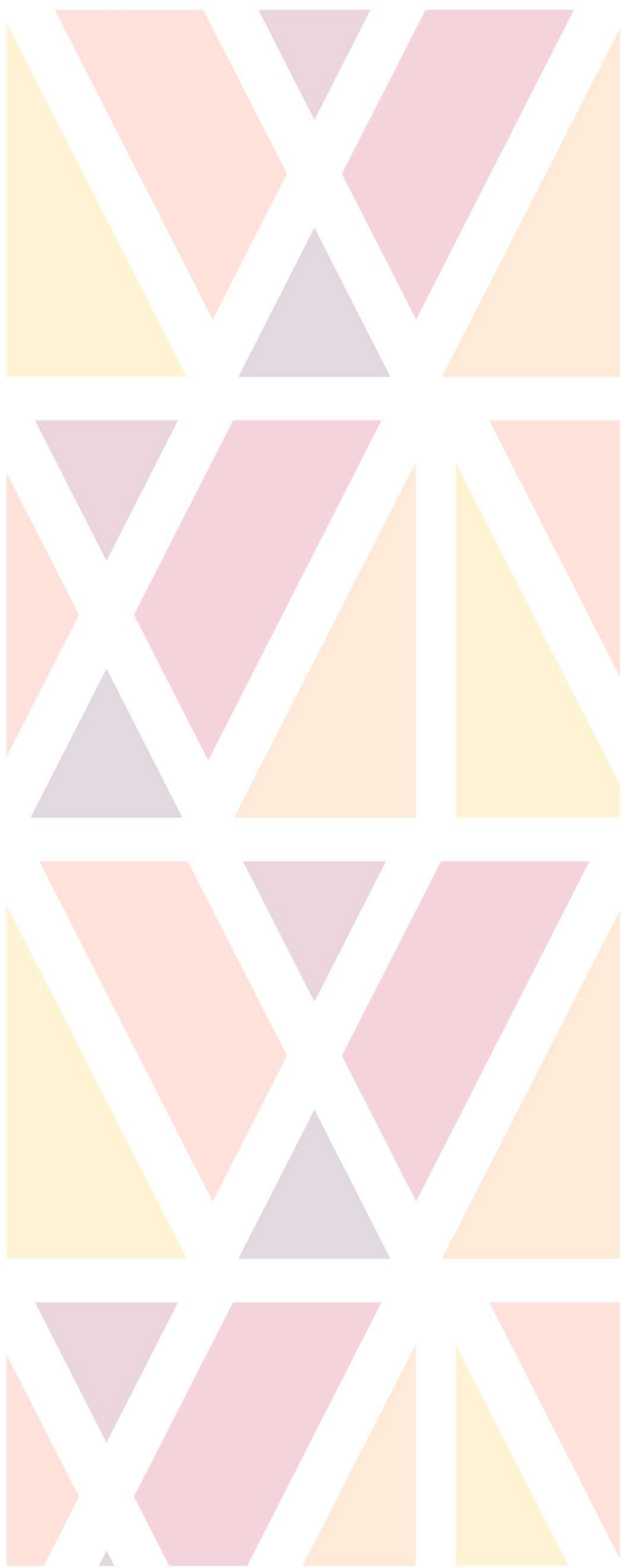

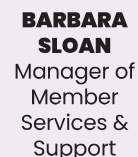
A Few Buzzwords About the Business of Belonging to ABWA

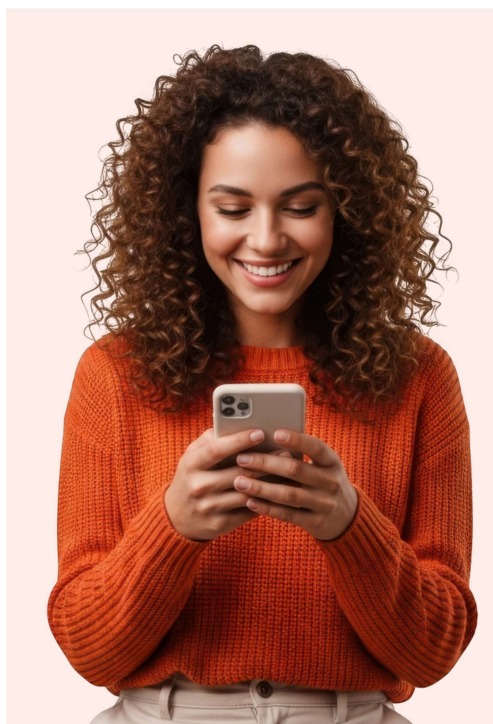

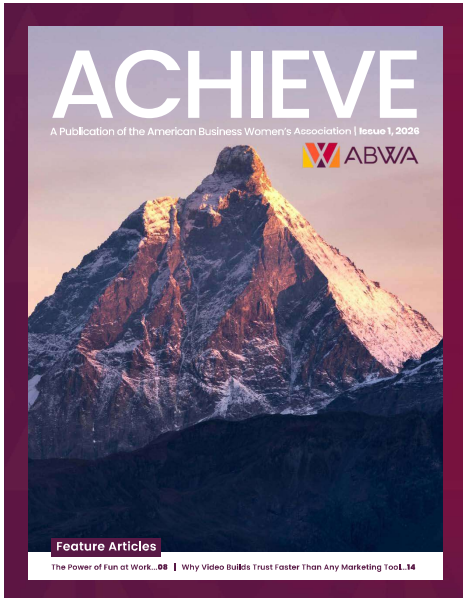

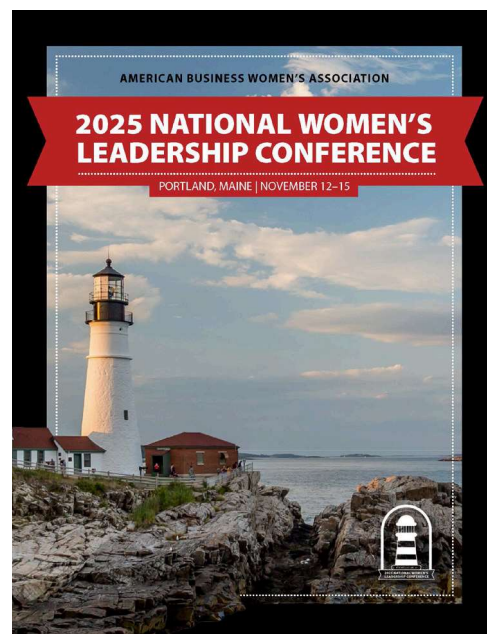
