She reported that 761 W. Kovaya moved their recreational vehicle to the south end of their lot thus screening it from the street and neighboring lots. The homeowners at 876 W. Samalayuca removed their travel trailer from the property. The homeowners at 975 W. Samalayuca moved their boat to the south end of their lot thus screening it from the street and neighboring lots.

In addition she contacted the homeowner at 951 W. Samalayuca regarding a violation of single family use per lot, informing him that renting the property and staying in the recreational vehicle on the lot is a violation of the CCRs. Also she contacted the neighbors at 826 W. Comobabi regarding adequately screening their recreational vehicle from neighboring lots and streets.
