<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Amy reported that she deposited \$5000 into the reserve account at Vanguard. Expenses for the month included \$4,700 to Community Association Underwriters for the Association's insurance, \$620 to the attorney, and \$1100 to Crane Machine and Pump for repairs.

## **Committee Reports:**

Architectural Review: No report due to no activity/requests.

Area A Committee: Amy reported that a new net and ping pong balls were purchased. Also, a cement table with 3 benches was purchased for \$275.

<u>Old Business</u>: The entry lights on Vamori are now working. The residence at 726 W. KoVaya reconnected the wire that was disconnected during their construction.

<u>New Business</u>: Improvements for 2019 were discussed. Some improvements to consider are to paint the outside of the buildings at Area A for an estimated cost of \$2500, replacing the entry lights at Vamori with solar lights, and patching and painting the backboard at the tennis court as well as the tennis court.

The Board will begin revisions on the CCRs at the January 8, 2019 Board meeting.
