



PARENT/CARER CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

At Hornsby RSL Gymnastics, we value the support of parents and carers in creating a safe, positive, and encouraging environment for all children and young people. By following this Code of Behaviour, you help us make the club a welcoming and respectful place for everyone.

As a parent/carer, I will:

Support my child positively

- Encourage effort, enjoyment, and improvement, not just results
- Celebrate my child's progress and show patience with their learning
- Help them understand that mistakes are part of learning

Respect coaches, staff, and volunteers

- Allow coaches to coach – I will not instruct my child from the sidelines
- Trust that coaches are acting in the best interest of each child's development
- Raise concerns privately and respectfully through the correct channels

Promote a safe and inclusive environment

- Treat all children, families, and staff with kindness and respect
- Support the club's commitment to child safety and wellbeing
- Be inclusive and welcoming to all families, regardless of background or ability

Be responsible and reliable

- Ensure my child attends regularly and arrives on time
- Collect my child promptly at the end of class
- Notify the club of absences or issues that may affect participation

I will not:

- Use rude, aggressive, or inappropriate language
- Criticise other children, coaches, or parents
- Tolerate or contribute to bullying, gossip, or discrimination

Breaches of this Code:

If this Code is not followed, the club may take action including:

- A verbal reminder or written warning
- A meeting with staff or management
- Suspension from the premises or club events in serious cases
