

ADDITIONAL TRIAL RULES

- 1 HOW TO ENTER: **MAIL** - To be acceptable, submit entry, with the required entry fee, on an official AKC entry form, or copy, including the agreement and instructions. Please type or neatly print.
- 2 The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
- 3 Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax or email entries will not be accepted.
- 4 The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- 5 **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT:**• MAILED entries will receive an email confirmation within 7 days after receipt, to the email address provided on the entry form. If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- 6 Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged.
- 7 Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
- 8 The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.
- 9 Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging or warm-up ring.
- 10 There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial grounds or premises.

- 11 In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
- 12 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, released by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the Trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 13 MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to start of Trial judging.
- 14 BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial, at the latest, to receive a refund.

Meiklejohn Lawn Area (Parking Lots A-B & D)

From Oakland Area, Take HWY 580 East to Hayward and exit on the Hayward exit, Continue on Foothill Blvd into downtown Hayward. Turn right onto "A" Street, two blocks, left onto Mission Blvd for several blocks. Turn left onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up hill, and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At stop sign, turn left and proceed to rear of campus. Turn right into Lot D, follow paved path to Meiklejohn lawn or park in Lots A-B, cross West Loop Rd., take elevator or stairs to Lawn area .

From San Jose Area, take HWY 880 North to Hayward. Exit Jackson Street eastbound. Turn right at first signal onto Santa Clara which becomes Harder Road. Follow Harder to campus. Turn left into Lot D, follow paved path to Meiklejohn lawn or park in Lots A-B, cross West Loop Rd., take elevator or stairs to Lawn area .

From SF Peninsula, take the San Mateo Bridge (HWY 92) east to Hayward. Continue past the intersection with HWY 880. Turn right at first signal onto Santa Clara which becomes Harder Rd. Follow Harder to campus. Turn right into Lot D, follow paved path to Meiklejohn lawn or park in Lots A-B, cross West loop Rd., take elevator or stairs to Lawn area .

There is to be NO **DRIVING ONTO THE GROUNDS**. Be prepared to haul your equipment along a paved walkway to the trial site. Access to Trial site is via the paved walkway from Lot D or use elevator or stairs from Lots A-B. Limited shade. Handlers may want to bring canopies to protect your dogs.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
