2. Why doesn't the state have anything to say about this guy just taking over the road and what is the DEC's position in this matter.
3. After 5 years won't the town lose ownership of the road anyway.

There was a long discussion around this subject with the final outcome being that somewhere there must be an old map which will show the boundaries. If anyone in Town has an old Harford map that we could look at it would be helpful.
