CITIZENS REQUEST/COMPLAINTS:

- 1. Bob Gardner, 6501 E Hillgrove Rd, Galion, attended meeting and presented complaint about potholes on E Hillgrove Road. Advised by trustees that this complaint is currently being addressed.
- 2. Acting on an anonymous phone call from a resident in the Chevy Chase Drive area who complained of farm animals and an offensive smell in the neighborhood. Rick Jeffrey, Zoning Inspector for Polk Twp., went to 260 Chevy Chase Drive, home of Alan and Rachel Akers to address the situation. The Akers' son answered the door and informed Rick that his parents were not home at this time. Rick left a note with the son asking the parents to call Rick's phone number.

Mr. Akers did call Rick, who informed Mr. Akers he was in violation of a "farm animals in residential area" zoning law. The interpretation of farm animals vs pets ensued. Mr. Akers requested the Section Numbers in Zoning Laws and Rick told him he could find them online.

Alan and Rachel Akers attended the May 15th Polk Twp. Meeting where the above-mentioned situation was discussed. In addition, Mr. Akers also presented a complaint against Rick Jeffrey claiming Rick addressed him during their phone conversation, by using an inappropriate name that questioned Mr. Aker's intelligence.

While discussing the farm animal situation, trustees asked Mr. Akers how many chickens, rabbits, and quail were kept on his property at 260 Chevy Chase Drive. Mr. Akers responded he had 15-20 chickens, 6 rabbits, and 30 quail.

Trustees informed Mr. Akers that circumstances surrounding this issue would be further investigates, and they would have the president of the Zoning Board review the situation as outlined in the Zoning Laws of Polk Twp. Rick Jeffrey was asked by trustees to supply Mr. Akers with the written section of zoning laws related to the present violation and additionally, to the zoning laws governing junk car violations.
