Regular Meeting August 21st, 2024 7:00 P.M.

CITIZENS REQUEST/COMPLAINTS:

Natalie Siclair brought up concerns about the intersection on Biddle Road and Galion New Winchester. There was an accident there on Monday. Citizen stated that she called the Galion PD and Sheriff's office about a report of how many accidents have occurred there. Board of Trustees stated they have talked to County about possible changes because of it being a county road and they have to propose changes to the county before they can be in effect. Limbs were cut down. Trustees also stated that the flashing lights on the stop signs are hard to approve. The other suggestion was rumble strips leading up to the signs as well. Citizen Noval was here for the same reason as she had seen an increase of traffic on Iberia Road. Citizen has stated that she has seen an increase of speeding, semi-trucks and vehicles running stop signs as well. Trustees stated that if roads are not certified they can't change the speed limit, so until it becomes certified they really can't do much. Trustees stated they will work more with the county and find other possible solutions to help prevent. Citizen Siclair stated she was able to contact Google to not reroute vehicles that might prevent issues from

occurring. However, legally the trustees can't deny vehicles because they pay taxes as well. The Trustees stated that they will continue to work on the issue.

Justin McDaniel requested more assistance to build a Barndominium on current property. Trustees and Zoning Inspector gave advise of separating the parcels off or having an agreement in writing stating that the older property would be torn down once the new home is livable; however, Justin is having an issue with the bank because the deed is stated with the property being 7 acres and anything less he would have to refinance with the bank. Discussion ensued on different possibilities and making the property a new address. That would have to be approved by the county and then they would have the township sign off on a form. Inspector Rick Jeffrey stated he would talk to Jeff from the Zoning Board of Appeals and see if it is possible and if there would be a need for a variation. However, the zoning code doesn't have any references for multiple dwellings on a parcel. Rick will get back to Justin about if the property can or can't before he moves forward and cost him any money.

Breaker for panel. Trustee Sellman stated that the cost with the panel would be about \$10,000. Dustin stated he can get a breaker but he doesn't know if it will fix the issue. The Cost was about \$1,400 but he didn't know if he was new or refurbished. Tom stated he would prefer to put a breaker in and if they don't work he would recommend moving the computer to a different breaker. Tom stated he would ask about a warranty and go with what Dustin thinks is best. Rusty will get ahold of him and on it.

Trustees revisited the sign proposal. Trustees had issues with possible mounting. Suggestions on painting the building but painter would have the issue with the grooves as well. A brief recess was taken to go outside and think about possible solutions for issue/proposal.
