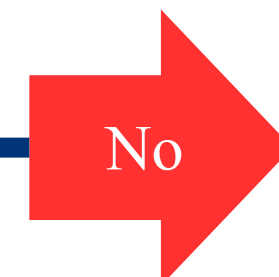


Is Equine-Assisted Therapy/Hippotherapy Right for my Child or Patient?



Does the child/patient experience difficulties with any of the following requiring skilled therapeutic intervention?

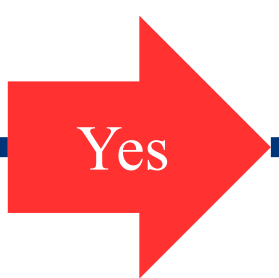
- Motor Skills (balance, coordination, motor planning)

Therapeutic Riding options



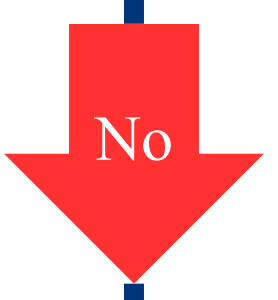
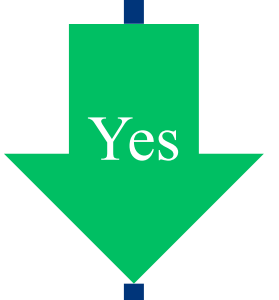
Has traditional therapies met the individual's needs in the past?
