How To Enter

1. We are inviting members of our floral art clubs, garden and horticultural clubs and from anyone who has a love of flowers and floral design to enter photographs of their designs into our virtual floral art show.
2. Register for the show with the Show Chairperson.

3. The deadline for registering your name, contact information and intended class entries is October 15th 2020.
4. Class sizes will be limited to 10 entries per class. You may enter as many classes as you wish, with 1 entry per class.
5. Unless otherwise specified, the design size maximum is 90 cm. (2' 11") width and depth. The height is the choice of the designer.
6. Staging and backing is also the designer's choice.
7. Please include a tape measure at the front of your design photograph to confirm the width of your design.
- 8.. When you have completed your designs, take 3 high resolution photographs of the finished design - the front, side and a close up - and email these to the Show Chairperson, clearly marking "Entry for the WAFAC Virtual Show".
9. Make a list, to attach to your entry, of your mechanics, any accessories, and the plant material used in the design.
10. The deadline for emailing to the Show Chairperson your photographs and the list of accompanying Information is Midnight, Sunday, 25th October 2020.
11. 1st, 2nd and 3rd placements will be made in each class.
12. Awards will be given for Best in Show and Best Use of Color
13. Award certificates will be emailed to the winners, 2nd and 3rd placements.

Classes

1. **Angles.** An Abstract – creative design.
2. **Whatever the weather.** Design style and weather forecast is the Designer's choice.
3. **How sweet the memory.** Design Incorporating a vintage container. May include accessories and fabric.
4. **Purity.** Creative line design.
5. **Forest Edge.** Design of choice. To include wood piece (or pieces) and stone.
6. **Tempting the taste buds.** A petite design. Max. 25 cm. or 10"
7. **Whimsical.** Design of choice.
8. **Colour n' rhythm.** A horizontal design. A table centre or elevated design. Size 90cm. width, depth and 40cm height.
9. **Masterpiece.** A design incorporating a frame.
10. **Colours of Fall.** Symmetrical triangle.
A class for novices only. (Has not won a first at a previous show).

General Rules

1. The exhibit judging will be in accordance with the B.C. Council of Garden Clubs Floral Design, Judging and Exhibiting Standards Manual 2017 and its definitions, etc. will apply.
2. The judges decisions are final.
3. An exhibit is defined as one or more placements, composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, staged within an allotted space.
4. Plant material must predominate.
5. Exhibits must be the individual exhibitor's own work. Purchased material may be used.
6. No artificial plant material may be used.
7. Painted and/or artificially coloured plant material may be used.
8. If the judges indicate NAS (not according to schedule) the entry is Disqualified. The reason for the disqualification will be given.
