# Shared Ride Overview



- Reservation-based service
- Curb-to-curb service **anywhere** in Lebanon County
  - \* restaurants \* salons \* banks \* movie theaters \* visit family & friends \*
  - Customers limited to 3 shopping bags or 1 upright cart*
- All vans are accessible
- 3 weekday trips to Hershey Medical Center Campus
- Service Times:
  - City Limits:** Mon-Fri 8am-5pm. Saturday 8am-4pm
  - County:** Mon-Fri 8am-3:30pm. **No Saturday County service.**

# Scheduling Rides



- Registration is required
- Shared Ride trips must be scheduled
- Schedule up to 2 weeks in advance until 4:00pm by calling 717.274.3514, Monday-Friday 8:00 – 4:00
- Next day reservations may be made Monday – Friday, but must be made by 2:00pm (ADA by 4:00pm)
- When scheduling, a return trip will be setup as well
- Customers are given a 30-minute pick-up window
  - **Must be ready to travel at the start of that window!**



# Cancel & No-Shows

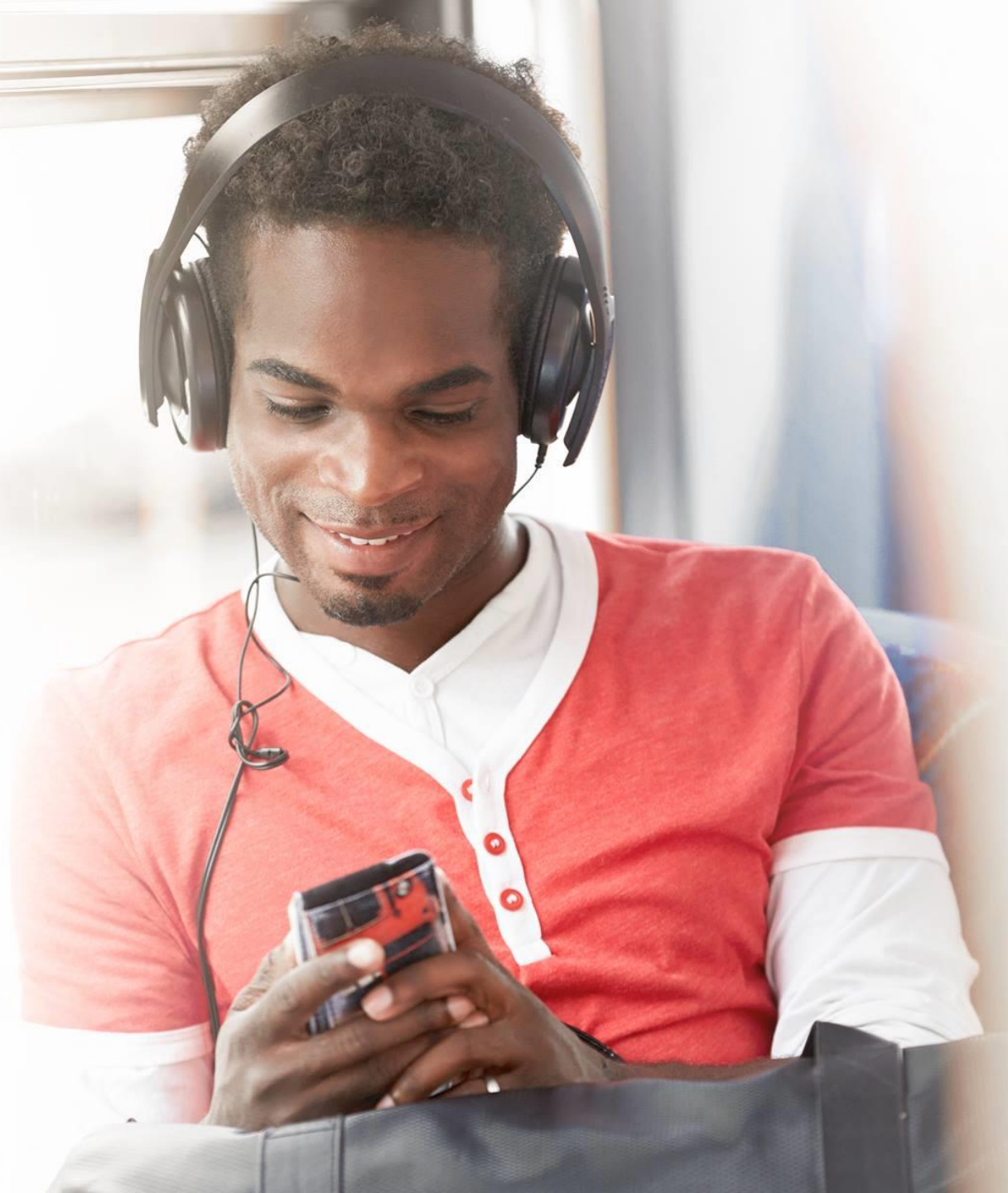


- To maintain cost effective and efficient travel, Shared Ride follows a No-Show Policy
- Trips may be cancelled **NO LATER** than 1 hour before the scheduled 30-minute pick up window
- A No-Show occurs when a customer does not board the vehicle within 5 minutes of the vehicle's arrival
- If there is a pattern of No-Shows a possible suspension of services may follow

# Subsidized Shared Ride Programs

## Senior Lottery

- Available to persons 65+ years-old
- **\$2.50 each way fare**
- Requires application and proof of age
- Subsidized by PA Lottery
- With Senior Transit Card, customers ride Fixed Route bus for **FREE**

## Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

- Available to persons:
  - with a verified disability; and
  - who reside and travel within  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile of a fixed bus route
- Fares range from \$3 - \$4.50 each way
- Requires application and doctor verification of disability
- May take up to 21 days to approve



# Subsidized Shared Ride Programs

## Persons with Disability (PWD)

- Available to persons:
  - 18-64 years of age;
  - with a physician verified disability;
  - who travel to and from an area in Lebanon County that is not served by Fixed Route bus service (or, outside  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile of fixed routes)
- Fares range from \$3 - \$4 each way.
- Requires application and doctor verification of disability
  - Or Notice of Award from Social Security

## Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP)

- Only available for medical purposes and appointments
- Coordinated through Community Action Partnership (CAP)

# How to Pay



- Pay with cash to driver onboard vehicle
  - Lebanon Transit is an “exact change” company!
- Advance purchase a coupon book
  - Books available for full fare and all subsidized programs
  - All books may be purchased at Lebanon Transit main office
  - Senior coupon books **ONLY** may be purchased from driver
  - Cash or check accepted
- Online pre-pay with credit card
  - Under “Shop” on Lebanon Transit website
