Tryout Clinic:

Tryout clinic will take place on Monday, 2/28, Tuesday, 3/1, and Wednesday, 3/2, from 4:30-6:30 pm in the LTHS main gym. During the clinic, dancers will learn both a jazz and a kick routine, receive their tryout groups and numbers, discuss what is expected at tryouts, and participate in a mock tryout. Attendance is mandatory on all three days. If a hopeful misses a day of clinic, he or she will not be allowed to tryout. Dancers should wear school appropriate dance clothing, dance shoes, and hair up. Tryout clinic is closed to spectators and may not be video recorded. A video of the tryout routines will be available on the EE Tryout Google Classroom page after the first day of clinic. No food or drink is allowed in the gym except for water.

Emerald Elite Tryouts:

Tryouts for the 2022-2023 Emerald Elite Drill Team will be held on Thursday, March 3, 2022 at 5:00 pm in the LTHS main gym. All hopefuls must be an enrolled 9th-12th grade student at Lebanon Trail High School for the 2022-2023 school year. Candidates should report to the dance room (F120) by 4:30 pm and will be escorted into the gym when it is their turn to tryout. Tryouts are closed to spectators. Candidates are expected to stay for the entirety of auditions and callbacks (if needed). Dancers should wear the following:

- Black tank top or short sleeve shirt (tight fitting and school appropriate)
- Black leggings (ankle length)
- Black jazz shoes with black socks OR half shoes
- Hair in a slicked up high bun
- Performance make-up
- No jewelry except stud earrings

Scoring:

Hopefuls will be scored by a panel of judges, and their decision is final. Judges will not refer to hopefuls by name, only numbers will be used. In accordance with FISS Fine Arts Department policy, LTHS Emerald Elite hopefuls must earn a score of at least 70 points out of 100 in order to make the team. There is no minimum or maximum number of spots available. If a candidate makes a 70 or higher, he or she will be a member of the new team. Viewing score sheets must be done within 5 school days of tryouts.

Announcement of the 2022-2023 Emerald Elite Drill Team:

The new team will be announced via the Emerald Elite website (www.lthsemeraldelite.com) using numbers only. The list of new team members will be posted on Friday, 3/4, at 4:45 pm. If a hopeful is not selected for the team, he or she is highly encouraged to enroll in the Drill Team Training course at Lebanon Trail. Taking this course will help dancers gain the skills necessary to improve technique and prepare for the following year's tryout.

Emerald Elite's Year at a Glance

New Team Practices:

New team practices will start after team tryouts and are mandatory. They will be held after school from 4:30-6:30 pm. Some of these practices will be utilized as a fitting for uniforms, practice items, spirit wear, etc.

Summer Dance Classes:

Emerald Elite members are expected to take studio dance classes over the summer. Class schedules and hour expectations will be given before the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

Line Camp:

All Emerald Elite members must attend Crowd Pleasers Line Camp on August 2-4 at Lebanon Trail High School. This is a time for the team to get to know one another, develop both dance and leadership skills, and learn routines for the upcoming year.

Summer Practices:

Summer practices start shortly before school begins. These practices are mandatory for all members as we will be working on football routines, stand routines, contest routines, and conditioning for the fall.

Football Season:

Emerald Elite will perform at all football games, home and away, as well as potential playoff games. Members will be required to try out for each halftime performance. Football games are mandatory.

Basketball Season:

We will perform our contest routines at select basketball games throughout the season. We will only attend games held at LTHS with the exception of potential playoff games. Attendance at these events is mandatory.

Contest Season:

Emerald Elite will attend 2 regional competitions in 2023. All members will be required to try out for each contest routine. Practices for contest season will be held before school, after school, and on some Saturdays.

Spring Show:

Our annual Spring Show will be held in the LTHS auditorium. This will be an opportunity for the team to showcase all the work they have done throughout the year.

Emerald Elite Fundraisers

Emerald Elite Merit and Demerit System

Purpose

In order to be a productive and successful team, it is necessary that each team member be responsible to uphold a discipline system and FISD Code of Conduct. The purpose of the merit/demerit system is to enhance our organization in a positive way by holding each team member to a standard for team rules, policies, and procedures. The merit/demerit system will be enforced at all times. Each team member is expected to know, understand, and follow the system. The Director will issue and keep record of merits and demerits. Merits and demerits will be recorded once the new team is selected and will be in effect until the end of the Emerald Elite's year. Members will begin each Emerald Elite year with a "zero balance" of merits and demerits.

Merit System Guidelines

The merit system is designed to reward members for positive behavior. Opportunities to earn merits will be provided throughout the year by the Director. One merit will erase one demerit if the merit is earned prior to receiving the demerit. Earning a merit is the only way to remove a demerit from an Emerald Elite's record.

Demerit System Guidelines

The demerit system is designed to hold members accountable for team rules, policies, and procedures. Demerits may be erased by earning merits. Upon receiving a demerit, the member will perform physical conditioning and sign the merit/demerit log.

Probation

A member will be placed on probation if he/she earns **ten** demerits. The duration of the probation period will be determined by the director. Members will attend all rehearsals. Members may wear the team uniform and attend social activities related to dance team while on probation. A contract will be written and must be signed by the member,

parent, and director. If the member is placed on probation due to loss of eligibility for UIL grading purposes, the team member may not wear the performance uniform, travel, or sit with the team. The team member may attend educational field trips, but he/she may not participate or assist with a public performance. Probation will result in sitting out from all performances within the probation period. If there is not a scheduled performance during the probation period, the team member may be pulled from performances that occur after the probation period has ended. In addition to the Emerald Elite Merit/Demerit System, all guidelines stated in the FISD Extracurricular Code of Conduct will also apply.

Suspension

A member will be suspended if he/she earns **fifteen** demerits. The duration of the suspension period will be determined by the director. Members will attend all rehearsals. Members may not wear any part of the team uniform to school or activities. Members may not attend social activities related to dance team. Members may not travel or sit with the dance team at performance events or public activities. A contract will be written and must be signed by the member, parent, and director. Suspension will result in sitting out from all performances within the suspension period, as determined by the director. If there is not a scheduled performance during the suspension period, the team member may be pulled from performances that occur after the suspension period has ended. In addition to the Emerald Elite Merit/Demerit System, all guidelines stated in the FISD Extracurricular Code of Conduct will also apply.

Dismissal

A member will be considered for dismissal from the team if he/she accumulates **twenty or more** demerits, even if he/she has not encountered probation or suspension. If a member is removed from the team, he/she must turn in all school equipment and uniforms and clear all financial obligations within one week of dismissal. Dismissal will require a meeting with the campus principal. In addition to the Emerald Elite Merit/Demerit System, all guidelines stated in the FISD Extracurricular Code of Conduct will also apply.

Inherent Risk Sheet- *to be turned in prior to tryouts*

INHERENT RISKS OF DANCE TEAM:

Dance Team participation is reasonably safe as long as certain guidelines are followed, but there is the inherent risk of injury as in any athletic activity. Dance Team is an anaerobic/aerobic activity which includes jumping, stunting, motions, and tumbling. All physicals must be on file in the high school office before you may participate in practices and games. Keep your sponsor informed of all injuries and/or chronic conditions.

Although the probability of injury is minimized if you practice correctly, there is always the possibility of one occurring. Injuries that can occur in Dance Team include, but are not limited to, the following: *Blisters, muscle strains, ligament sprains, joints and muscle soreness, abrasions, contusions, stress fractures, broken bones, spinal cord injuries involving paralysis, and even death. However, if you take certain precautions, the possibility of such injuries will be largely decreased.*

BE SURE TO CONSISTENTLY ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- NEVER stunt or tumble unless a sponsor or sponsor's designee is present
- Always practice in the presence of a qualified teacher
- Always warm-up appropriately before dancing (practice and games) by jogging & stretching
- Do not attempt a stunt that you do not know how to perform safely and that has not been checked off by the teacher
- Always use attentive spotters when stunting
- Always dance in an area free from obstruction
- Always use mats or a grassy area when stunting during practice
- Do not stunt on uneven ground, wet surfaces, and concrete. Do not stunt in cold or rainy weather
- Never talk, laugh, mess around when performing a stunt
- Report all injuries to the coach as soon as they occur
- Follow all trainer and doctor recommendations
- Lift weights to increase strength and guard against injuries
- Always wear shoes and clothing appropriate for Dance Team
- Never wear jewelry of any kind or chew gum when dancing (practice and games)
- Always have your hair pulled back from your face and shoulders
- Eat nutritious meals and get plenty of rest
- Always ask for assistance or advice at any time
