### **Tryout Information Continued**

#### **Tryout Clinic:**

Tryout clinic will take place on Monday, 3/3, Tuesday, 3/4, and Wednesday, 3/5, from 4:30-6:30 pm in the LTHS main gym. During the clinic, dancers will learn a jazz/kick routine, receive their tryout groups and numbers, discuss what is expected at tryouts, and participate in a mock tryout. Attendance is mandatory on all three days. If a hopeful misses a day of clinic, he or she will not be allowed to try out. If an emergency arises, please be sure to communicate with Ms. Cook and options will be discussed privately. Dancers should wear school appropriate dance clothing, dance shoes, and hair up. Tryout clinic is closed to spectators and may not be video recorded. A video of the tryout routines will be available on the EE Tryout Google Classroom page after the first day of clinic. No food or drink is allowed in the gym except for water.

#### **Emerald Elite Tryout DAY:**

Tryouts for the 2025-2026 Emerald Elite Drill Team will be held on **Thursday, March 6th, 2024 at 5:00 pm** in the LTHS main gym. All hopefuls must be an enrolled 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade student at Lebanon Trail High School for the 2025-2026 school year. Candidates should report to the dance room (F120) by 4:30 pm and will be escorted into the gym when it is their turn to try out. Tryouts are closed to spectators. Candidates are expected to stay for the entirety of auditions and callbacks (if needed). Dancers should wear the following:

- Black tank top or short sleeve shirt (tight-fitting and school-appropriate)
- Black leggings (ankle length)
- Skin Toned Pirouette (half) Shoes
- Hair in a slicked back low bun (you may have a part)
- Performance make-up
- · No jewelry except stud earrings

#### **Scoring:**

Hopefuls will be scored by a panel of judges, and their decision is final. Judges will not refer to hopefuls by name, only numbers will be used. In accordance with FISD Fine Arts Department policy, LTHS Emerald Elite hopefuls must earn a score of at least 70 points out of 100 in order to make the team. There is no minimum or maximum number of spots available. If a candidate makes a 70 or higher, he or she will be a member of the new team. Viewing score sheets must be done within a two week time frame after spring break.

#### Announcement of the 2025-2026 Emerald Elite Drill Team:

The new team will be announced via the Emerald Elite website (<a href="www.lthsemeraldelite.com">www.lthsemeraldelite.com</a>) using numbers only. The list of new team members will be posted on Thursday evening, 3/6, after tryouts. If a hopeful is not selected for the team, he or she is highly encouraged to enroll in the Drill Team Training course at Lebanon Trail. Taking this course will help dancers gain the skills necessary to improve technique and prepare for the following year's tryout.

### **Emerald Elite's Year at a Glance**

#### **New Team Practices:**

New team practices will start after team tryouts and are mandatory. They will be held after school from 4:30-6:30pm. Some of these practices will be utilized as a fitting for uniforms, practice items, spirit wear, etc.

#### **Summer Dance Classes:**

Emerald Elite members are expected to take studio dance classes over the summer. Class schedules and hour expectations will be given before the end of the 2024-2025 school year.

#### **Line Camp:**

All Emerald Elite members must attend Crowd Pleasers Line Camp on May 27th-29th at Lebanon Trail High School. This is a time for the team to get to know one another, develop both dance and leadership skills, and learn ALL football routines for the upcoming year.

#### **Work Week:**

Summer practices (work week) will start shortly before school begins. These practices are mandatory for all members as we will be working on football routines, stand routines, contest routines, and conditioning for the fall. These practices will be one week before school starts.

#### **Football Season:**

Emerald Elite will perform at all football games, home and away, as well as potential playoff games. Football games are mandatory. During this season, members will be learning contest routines, and preparing for holiday events or possible holiday shows.

#### **Winter Season**

After football season, we will be preparing for our Winter Showcase, Contest and attending other extra events such as the Frisco Toy Drive, Community Service Events, Winter Pep Rally and other events that we may be invited to.

#### **Contest Season:**

Emerald Elite will attend 2 regional competitions in 2026. All members will be required to try out for each contest routine. Practices for contest season will be held before school, after school, and on some Saturdays.

#### **Spring Show:**

Our annual Spring Show will be held in the LTHS auditorium. This will be an opportunity for the team to showcase all the work they have done throughout the year.

#### Extra:

Throughout the year, Emerald Elite is invited to perform or make appearances at events such as; new sponsorships, Frisco Toy Drive, Kilgore College, possible out of town trips, community service etc. These events are usually voluntary but are wonderful experiences. Each member who attends these extra events will receive merits and/or volunteer service hours.

#### Inherent Risk Sheet- to be turned in prior to tryouts

#### **INHERENT RISKS OF DANCE TEAM:**

Dance Team participation is reasonably safe as long as certain guidelines are followed, but there is the inherent risk of injury as in any athletic activity. Dance Team is an anaerobic/aerobic activity which includes jumping, stunting, motions, and tumbling. All physicals must be on file in the high school office before you may participate in practices and games. Keep your sponsor informed of all injuries and/or chronic conditions.

Although the probability of injury is minimized if you practice correctly, there is always the possibility of one occurring. Injuries that can occur in Dance Team include, but are not limited to, the following: Blisters, muscle strains, ligament sprains, joints and muscle soreness, abrasions, contusions, stress fractures, broken bones, spinal cord injuries involving paralysis, and even death. However, if you take certain precautions, the possibility of such injuries will be largely decreased.

#### BE SURE TO CONSISTENTLY ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

NEVER stunt or tumble unless a sponsor or sponsor's designee is present

Always practice in the presence of a qualified teacher

Always warm-up appropriately before dancing (practice and games) by jogging & stretching

Do not attempt a stunt that you do not know how to perform safely and that has not

been checked off by the teacher Always use attentive spotters when stunting

Always dance in an area free from obstruction

Always use mats or a grassy area when stunting during practice

Do not stunt on uneven ground, wet surfaces, and concrete. Do not stunt in cold or rainy weather

Never talk, laugh, mess around when performing a stunt

Report all injuries to the coach as soon as they occur

Follow all trainer and doctor recommendations

Lift weights to increase strength and guard against injuries

Always wear shoes and clothing appropriate for Dance Team

Never wear jewelry of any kind of chew gum when dancing (practice and games)

Always have your hair pulled back from your face and shoulders

Eat nutritious meals and get plenty of rest

Always ask for assistance or advice at any time
