In IELTS speaking part 2, you might be asked to describe an activity, which can include a hobby, sport or game. I recommend that you prepare ideas for one sport (e.g. swimming) and one game (e.g. chess). As both can be used to describe a hobby, you will cover all three possibilities.

Look at these two examples and note the underlined vocabulary.

Describe an activity you like doing.
You should say:
what activity it is
who you do it with
how you do it and how often
and explain why you enjoy doing this activity.

I am a <u>keen</u> runner. I've been jogging for about five years now. It has become an essential part of my daily routine. I wake up early, have a quick breakfast and then go outside for a 5km run. I run for two main reasons.

First, I want to be <u>in good shape</u> and running is a good <u>cardiovascular workout</u>. It definitely makes me healthier. I also want to be slim, and running is a really effective way to <u>burn calories</u>.

Secondly, running is really good for my mental health. It makes me feel <u>refreshed</u> and <u>rejuvenated</u>. When I don't run, I tend to feel more tired and depressed. I find that running gives me an energy <u>boost</u> for the rest of the day.

Keen: wanting to do something very much.

<u>In good/bad, etc shape</u>: in good/bad, etc health or condition

<u>Cardiovascular</u>: relating to the heart <u>Workout</u>: a period of physical exercise

Burn calories: to destroy calories

Refreshed: less hot or tired.

<u>Rejuvenated</u>: to feel energetic again.

Boost: to improve or increase something.

I played on the PlayStation 2 games console with my two brothers. The game that we enjoyed the most was called Pro Evolution Soccer 2. It is a football <u>simulation</u> game and we were really addicted to it. It was a <u>multiplayer</u> game, so we could compete against each other.

Games console: a piece of electronic equipment for playing games on.

Simulation: a model of a real activity.

<u>Multiplayer</u>: used to refer to computer games in which several players can compete against each other.

<u>Fan</u>: someone who admires and supports a person, sport, sports team, etc.

Competitive: wanting very much to win.

<u>Hang out</u>: to spend a lot of time in a place or with someone.

Bond: a close connection joining two or more people.
