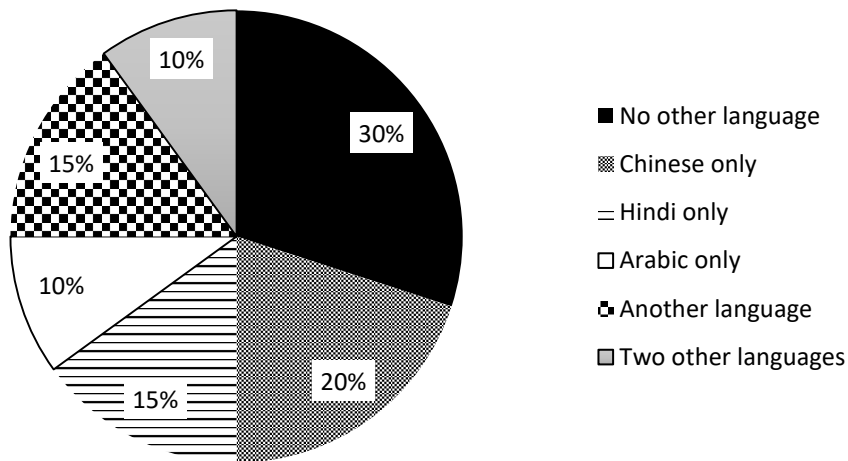

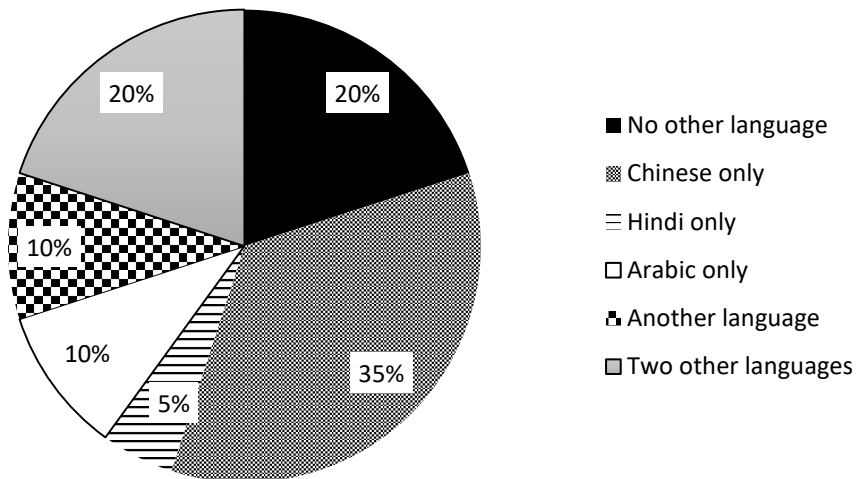

% of Australian Students able to speak language other than English, 2015



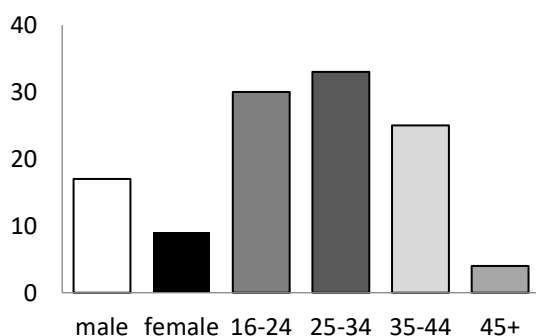

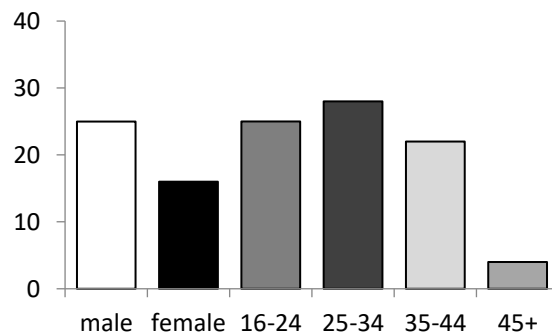

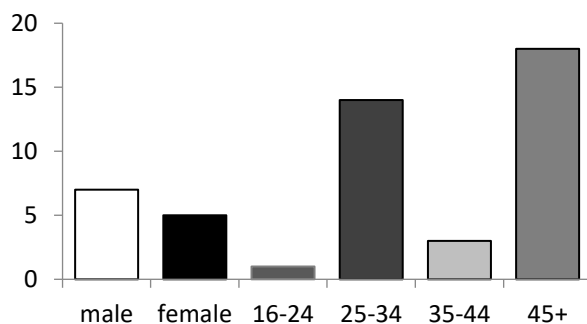
Percentage of people who buy pop music
