SEE THE VALUE

Before you begin your remodel, it’s important to remind yourself that it’s an investment. So while the process can be daunting, remember that even the smallest remodeling project can greatly improve your quality of life and increase the value of your home. Make sure to set a clear vision for what you’d like to accomplish and what you’re willing to spend. A Waypoint designer can work with you to make the most of your budget and create a living space you’ll love spending time in.

GO WITH THE FLOW

Let’s be honest, as exciting as the prospect of a new kitchen or bathroom is, your remodel will be disruptive to your everyday routine for a little while. The good news is there are many things you can do to prepare such as set up a temporary kitchen, or designate a space for storing deliveries (see our Remodel Checklist for even more tips). Sure, there will be a few curveballs, but the more prepared you are, the better you can handle whatever comes your way.

INFORM FAMILY & NEIGHBORS

Setting expectations is key, so discuss the renovation process and approximate the duration of the project with your family. Let them know to steer clear of work areas, and walk through how they can use alternative areas of the home for their day-to-day needs. And don’t forget to advise your neighbors of your project. Making them aware goes a long way toward having their support as you upgrade your new living space.

COMMUNICATE WITH CONTRACTORS

It’s a good idea to communicate with contractors early and often. Your Waypoint designer will help lead the conversation and manage the project by setting a schedule, determining hours of work, and assisting with many important details along the way. Safety is paramount, so be sure to insist that workers put away all power tools at the end of each day. Don’t be afraid to ask questions and be explicit about what you want—contractors are there to bring your vision to life.

- [] Remove pictures from adjacent walls
- [] Change air filters

CREATE A TEMPORARY KITCHEN

- [] Choose a room that has a water source
- [] Use a laundry room or bathroom for dishwashing
- [] Set up a microwave and coffeemaker
- [] Fire up the grill
- [] Stock up on paper plates and plastic flatware
- [] Eat out often

SUPPORT YOUR INSTALLERS

- [] Designate a bathroom for workers
- [] Designate a secure tool storage area
- [] Identify parking locations
- [] Insist on work-area cleanup every day

GET READY FOR DELIVERY

- [] Designate a storage area for your new cabinets
- [] Inspect your cabinets upon delivery
- [] Contact your Waypoint authorized designer if anything is amiss
- [] Count on Waypoint Rapid Resolution within 72 hours
- [] Trust that Waypoint deliverers will confirm your order and lay down protective runners on your floor

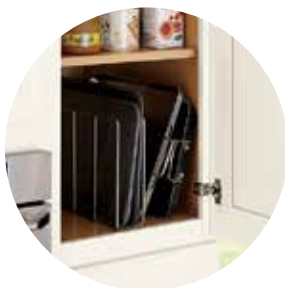

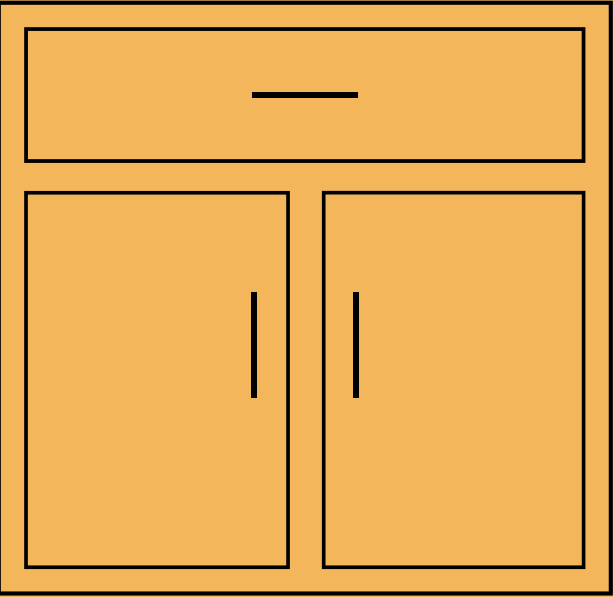
Cabinetry 101

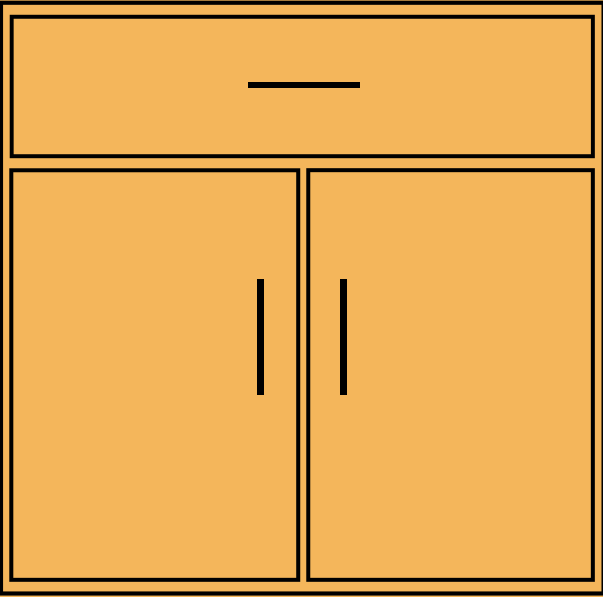
