- 3. Wait for a notification or link to appear on your screen (often at the bottom, often in yellow)
- 4. **Tap the notification or link** to open the Candlewood resident form associated with the QR code.

Please know that this updated contact information is important as we will be utilizing email for invoicing and correspondence whenever possible in an effort to reduce costs and increase communication amongst your HOA.

- Remove unused boats in "storage" on the lake or on their lawns

A big thank you to all our residents that work hard to maintain their property and follow the By-laws we currently have in place that keep our neighborhood clean and presentable.
