Etsuko Yasuoka and her assistant, Ms. Okazaki will join us for a very special demonstration and workshop on Saturday, February 8, 2020.

Etsuko lives in the city of Urayasu in Chiba, Japan, which is about 20 minutes away from Tokyo. She has been with the Koryu Shotokai School since 1972 as a student and then teaching for the last 33 years to Japanese and foreigners.

Living in many foreign countries, including the Middle East and the UK, Etsuko taught Ikebana and also the Japanese language for not only English speaking people, but also other Europeans in an adult school.

Etsuko Yasuoka has exhibited in many countries and is a member of the Ikebana International Tokyo Founding Chapter.



The Koryu style Ikebana began in the middle of the 18th century in the Edo period. The Seika style, which was initiated in the 18th century, has been passed down through the ages in the Koryu School. Another style created by the Koryu School in the course of its development is a free style Ikebana based on a modern approach, known as GENDAI-KA. Accordingly, the Koryu Shotokai School is now in possession of these two styles. In the Seika style, impressions direct from nature are held in high esteem.
