Diocesan Update on the Liturgy and Coronavirus

Due to the increasing incidences of coronavirus in our region, Bishop Christensen has issued the following directives for the Diocese of Boise regarding liturgical practices in light of this current public health concern.

- Most importantly, the faithful should be encouraged to stay home from Mass if they feel ill.
- Parishioners should avoid hand-to-hand contact during the Our Father and the Sign of Peace;
- Holy Water should be removed from fonts;
- Communion hosts should only be received in the hand, not on the tongue;
- The Precious Blood should not be distributed until further notice.
- Priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion should be especially reminded of the need to practice good hygiene. Ministers of Holy Communion should always wash their hands before Mass begins; a further precaution suggests using an alcohol-based anti-bacterial solution before and after distributing Holy Communion;

Bishop will continue to monitor the situation and will advise parishes regarding a return to normal liturgical practices when it is safe to do so.
