Digital Platform Union Leaders Meet with Acting Secretary of Labor Julie Su Ahead of G20 in Brazil

Between July 23-26, Brazil's Ministry of Labor and Employment hosted the second of two Working Group meetings on Employment in Fortaleza, Ceará ahead of the G20 Leaders' Summit which will take place in Rio de Janeiro later this year. Parallel to the official agenda, the Solidarity Center in Brazil facilitated a conversation between digital platform union leaders and the U.S. Department of Labor.
