Dear Parent/Guardian,

Covid-19 Update

From 01 April 2022 the Covid guidance on isolation and testing has changed.

A quick overview of actions to take:

- **Child Unwell** - return to school when feeling well enough to do so.
- **Child has a temperature** - return to school when temperature normal.
- **Child tested positive for Covid-19** - return 3 days after first positive test (if well enough).
- **If your child is not well enough to attend school, please follow normal absence reporting procedures.** They should **return to school as soon as they are well enough** to do so.
- **If your child is unwell and they have a high temperature, they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people.** They can **return to school when they no longer have a high temperature** and they are well enough to attend. Please let us know that your child has a high temperature when following normal absence reporting procedures.
- If you purchase a lateral flow test (many pharmacies such as Boots now provide this service) and your **child tests positive**, please report this to school. The advice is for your child to remain at home for **3 days before returning to school** if they are well enough to do so.
