









TTRS is an online game.

Playing little and often will significantly improve your child's recall of multiplication and division facts.

These are critical foundations in maths. Thorough knowledge of tables facts enables children to complete calculations more quickly and confidently. They link to many areas of the maths curriculum.

The children have been shown how to login and have brought home a username.

Children just need some quiet space to get on with the games for 10 minutes at a time. They may choose to play solo or against friends and challenge each other or their teachers.

Important: please don't allow siblings, friends or family to answer for your child but do support your child if they're stuck.



Little and often

In order to get the best out of TTRS children should regularly play for short bursts so we would ask that you give them 10 to 20 minutes play each day.




Everybody begins with a Gig Game.

A Gig game issues 100 multiplication questions starting with 10 questions on the 10s, followed by 10 questions on each of the 2s, 5s, 3s, 4s, 8s, 6s, 7s and 9s and then 5 questions on the 11s and the 12s. There is a 5 minute time limit and pupils will not necessarily get round to answering all 100 questions during that time, which is fine.


After their first Gig, pupils will be placed at the best starting point on the TTRS training course.

In addition, pupils are directed to play a Gig game after learning every table as a way to track performance over time and adjust their learning pathway as necessary.




Garage, Studio and Soundcheck allow pupils to compete against themselves, increasing their speed and accuracy which are tracked by the program.

Festival and Arena are multiplayer games which allow the children to compete against friends in school and further afield.


