Your child will soon be participating in this year's Christmas performance which is to be held in the main hall. You are invited to come along and watch their production of 'The Christmas Story'. As you will appreciate, the hall can only seat a certain number of people. In view of this, we need to issue tickets for the performance. To ensure that these are issued fairly, we need to restrict them to **two per family** initially. **(Please be aware that in the case of split families, the initial allocation will only cover one ticket for each parent)**. Once each family has had a chance to obtain two tickets, any remainder will go on general issue. (Again restricted to two additional per family).

There is no charge for tickets but they **must** be shown at the door on the day of the performance as entry cannot be gained without them. The performances are on the following dates:

Thursday 19th December (9.30AM performance)

Please complete the slip below showing which performance would be your first, second and third preference and we will try to accommodate this, although please be aware that we are restricted to 125 seats per performance so this cannot be guaranteed.

Please return the form to school by Tuesday 26th November to ensure your choice is noted.

Tickets will be issued on **Tuesday 3rd December** and any remaining will be on general release from **Friday 6th December at 8.00am** on a first come first served basis.
