

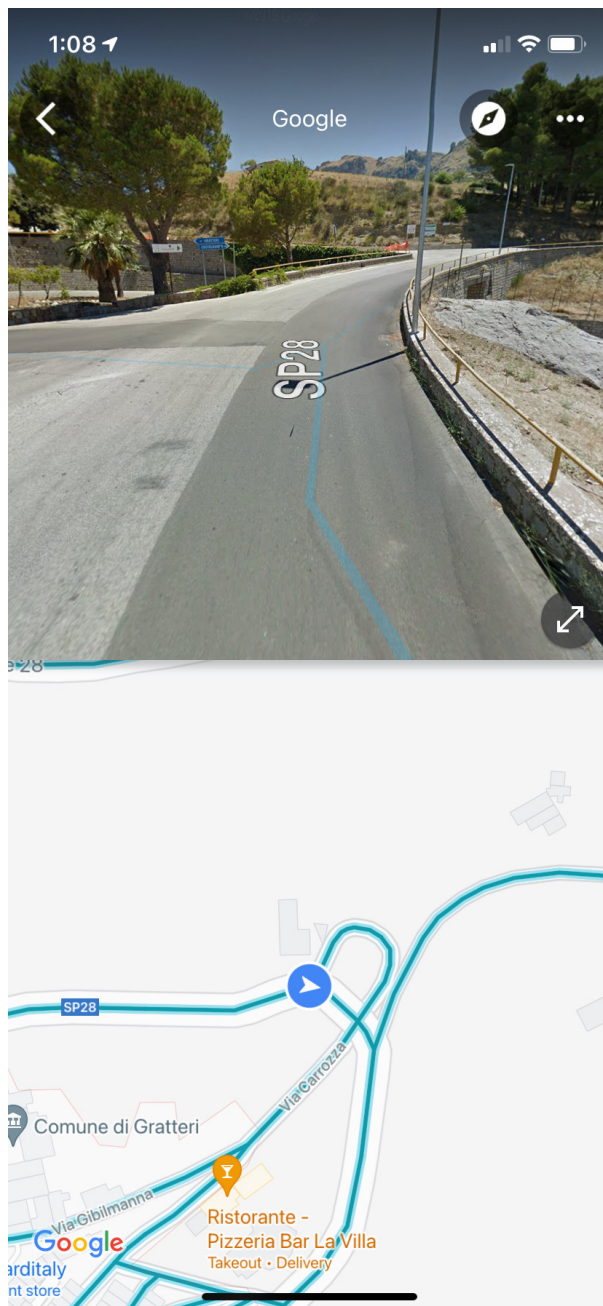
Directions to Via Scala 5A, Gratteri, Italy

The directions from Google will get you to the town, but DO NOT use Google to get you to the house once you enter Gratteri. You will wind up on a narrow little street that is too small for your car. We've done that.

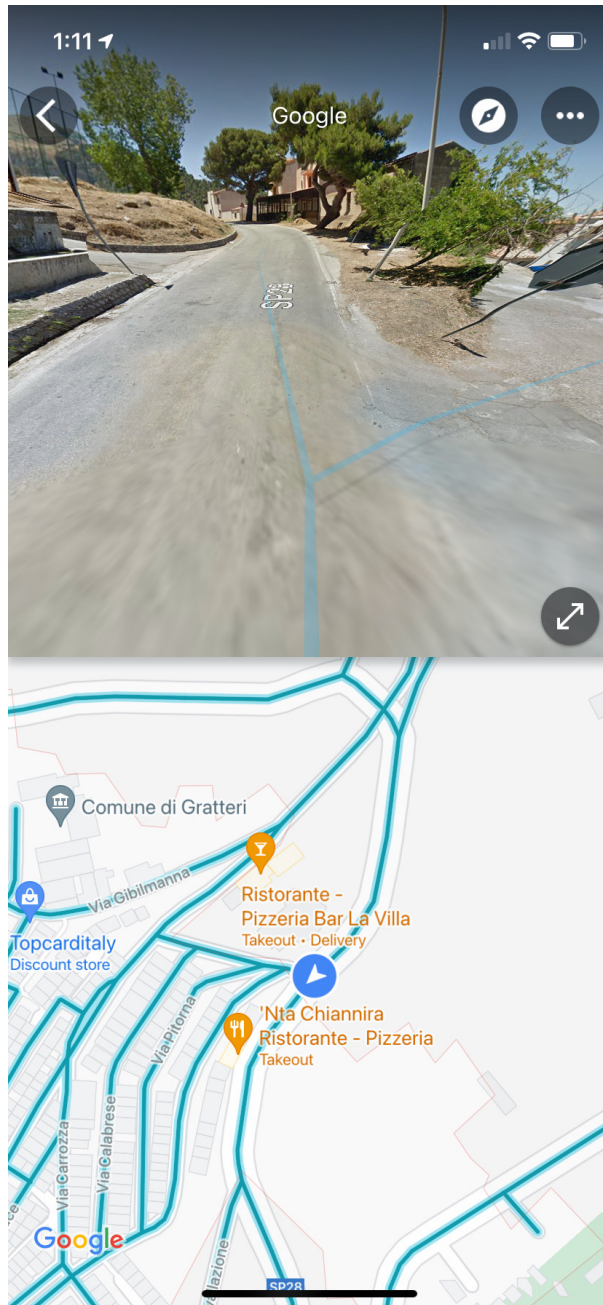
When you first arrive in the town, you will see this little roundabout. Go “left” – that is, around the circle to “9:00”



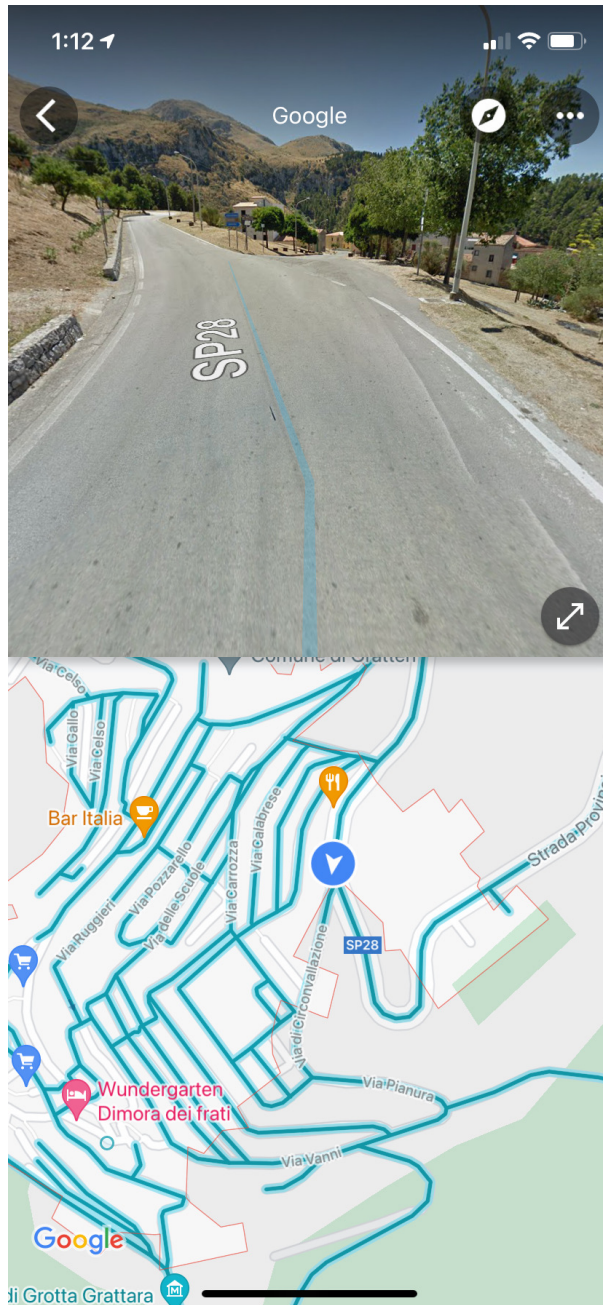
Stay on S.P. 28 and cross this bridge.



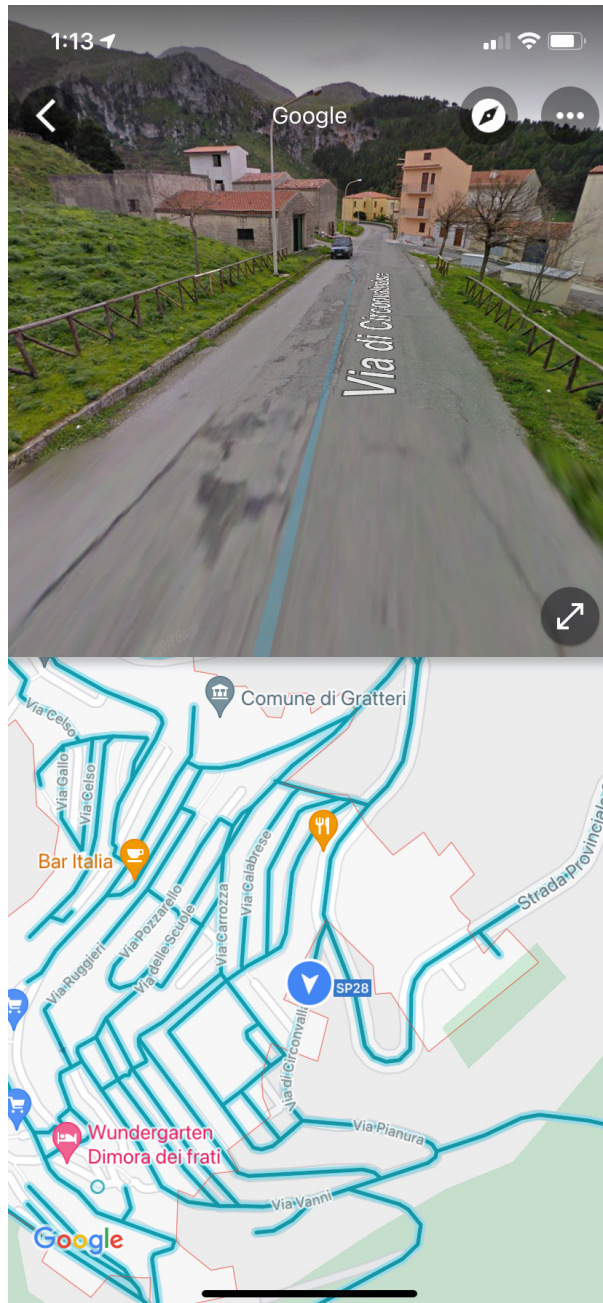
Stay straight on S.P. 28.



Stay to the right onto Via di Circonvallazione. DO NOT follow S.P. 28 any longer.



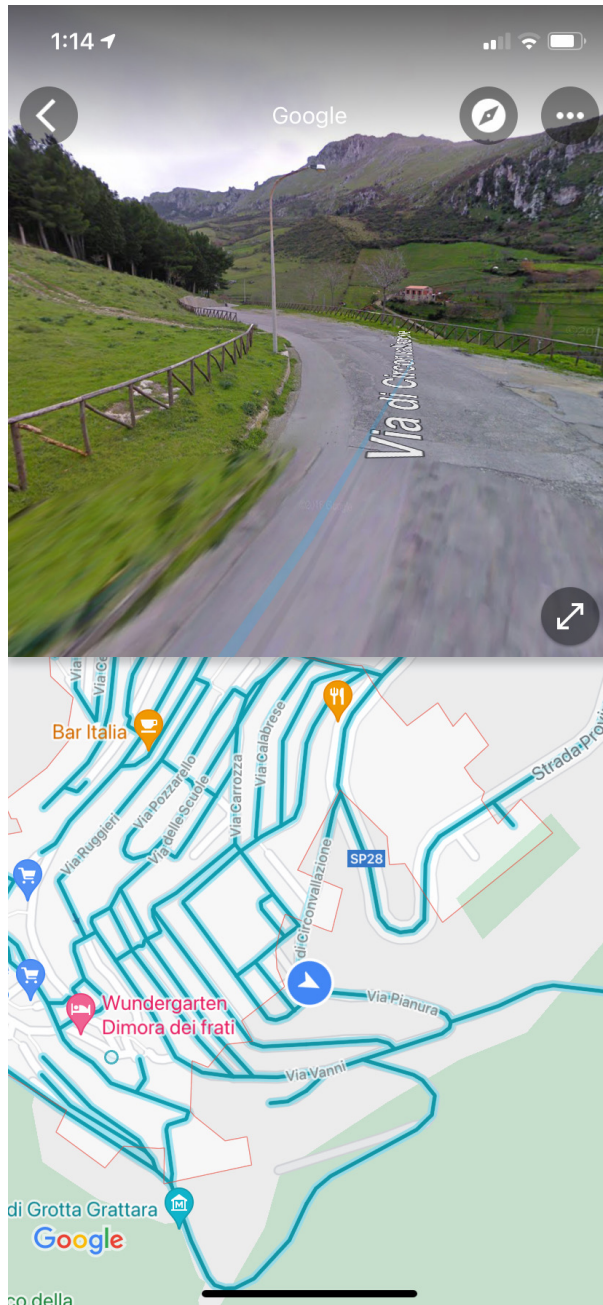
Stay straight on Via di Circonvallazione



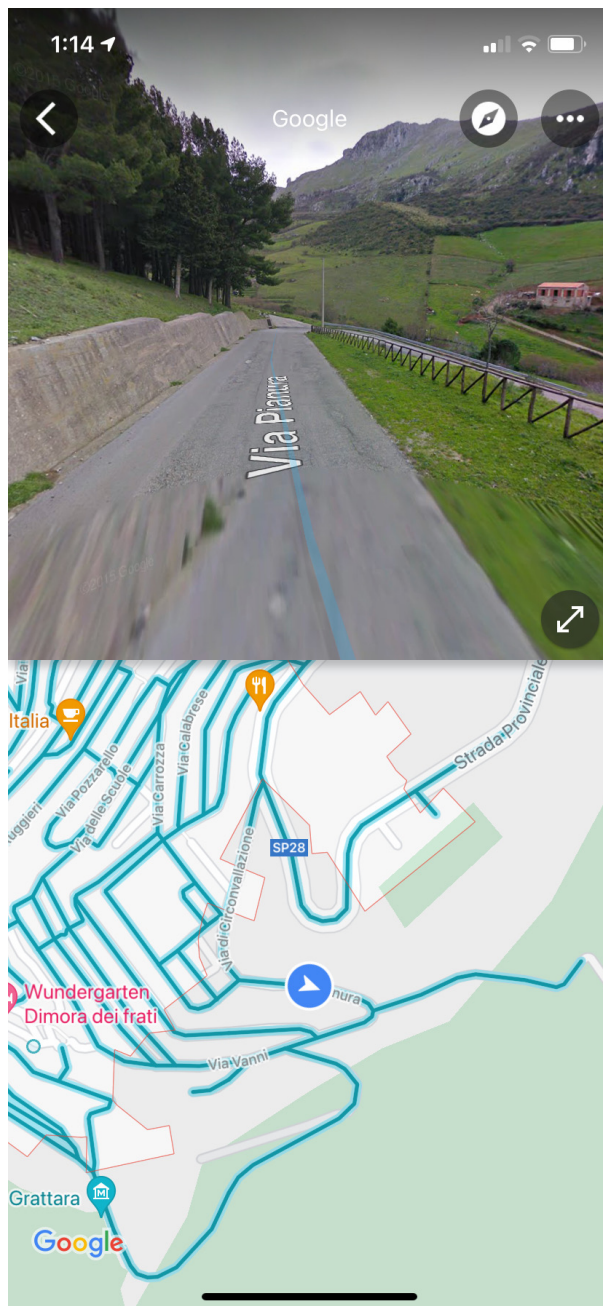
Stay left on Via di Circonvallazione



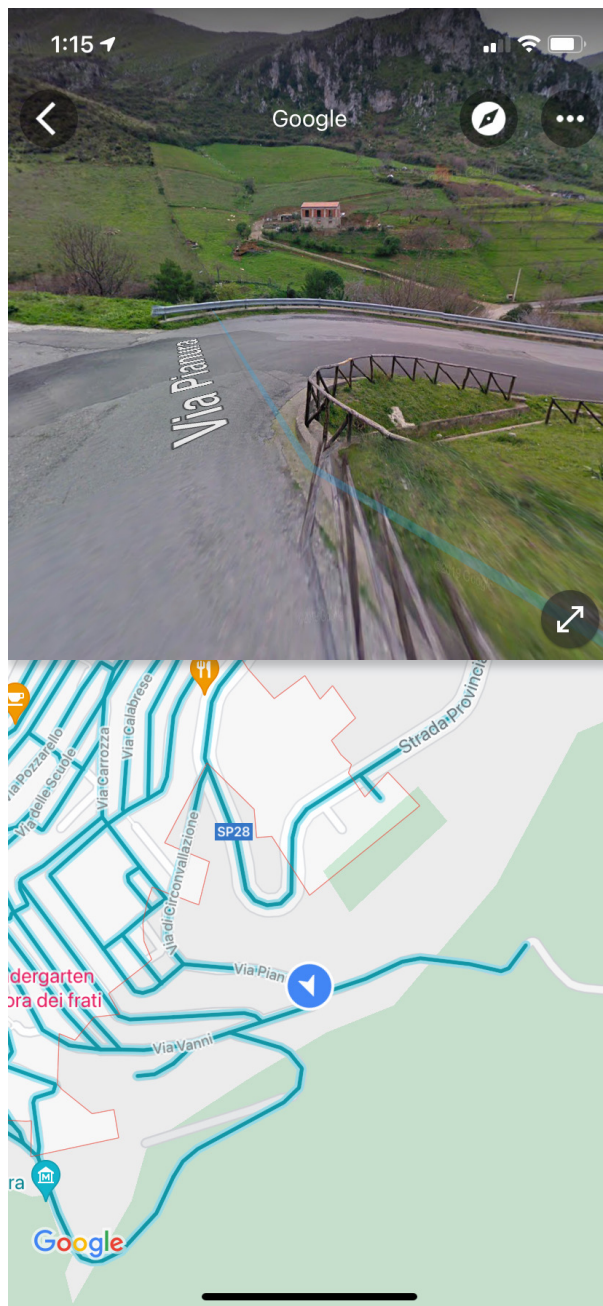
Follow Via di Circonvallazione

Pianura.



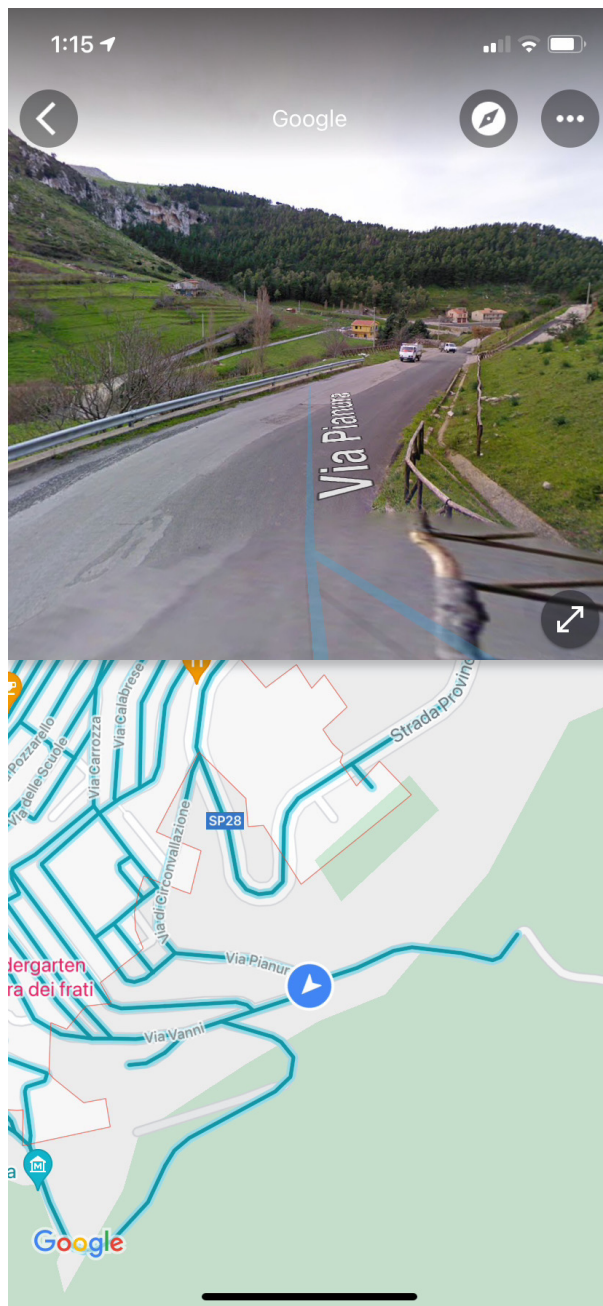
Continue to follow Via Pianura down the hill.



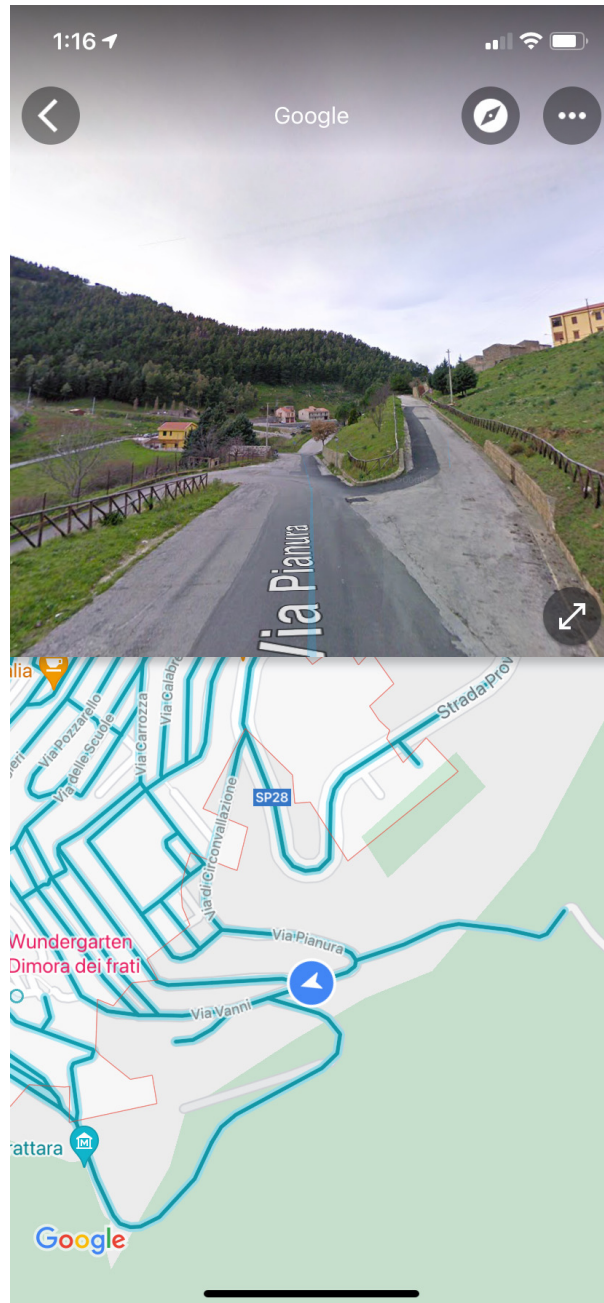
Continue to follow Via Pianura
down the hill.



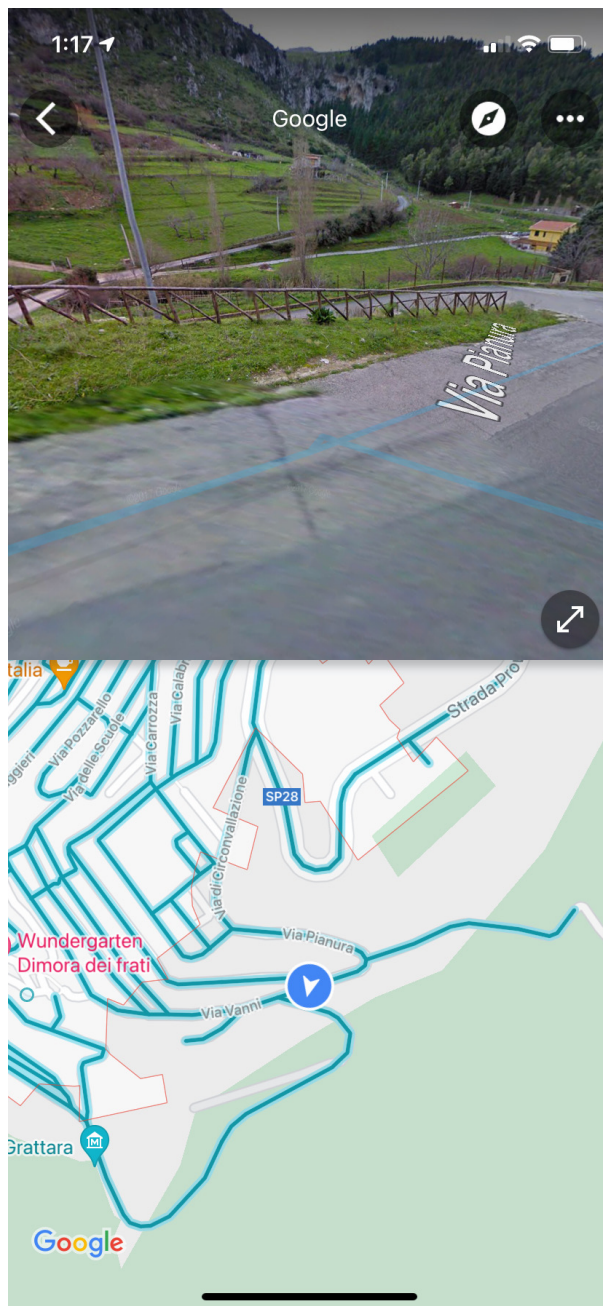
Follow Via Pianura to the right
as you continue down the hill.



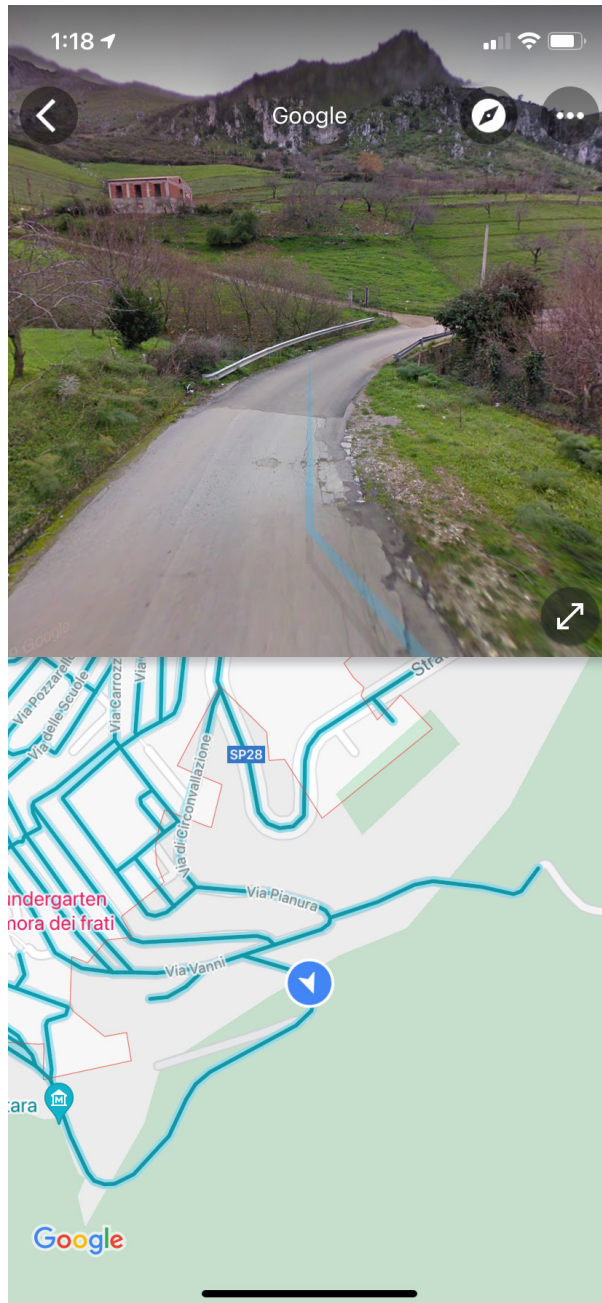
Stay to the left as you continue to follow Via Pianura down the hill.

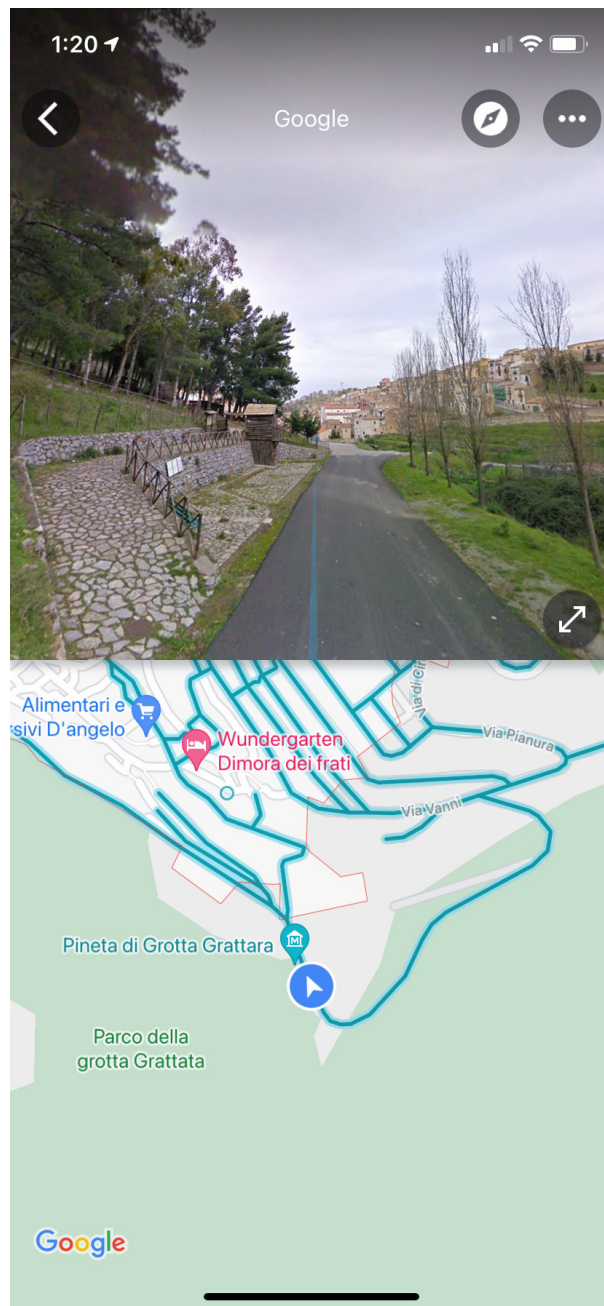
Cross this little bridge.



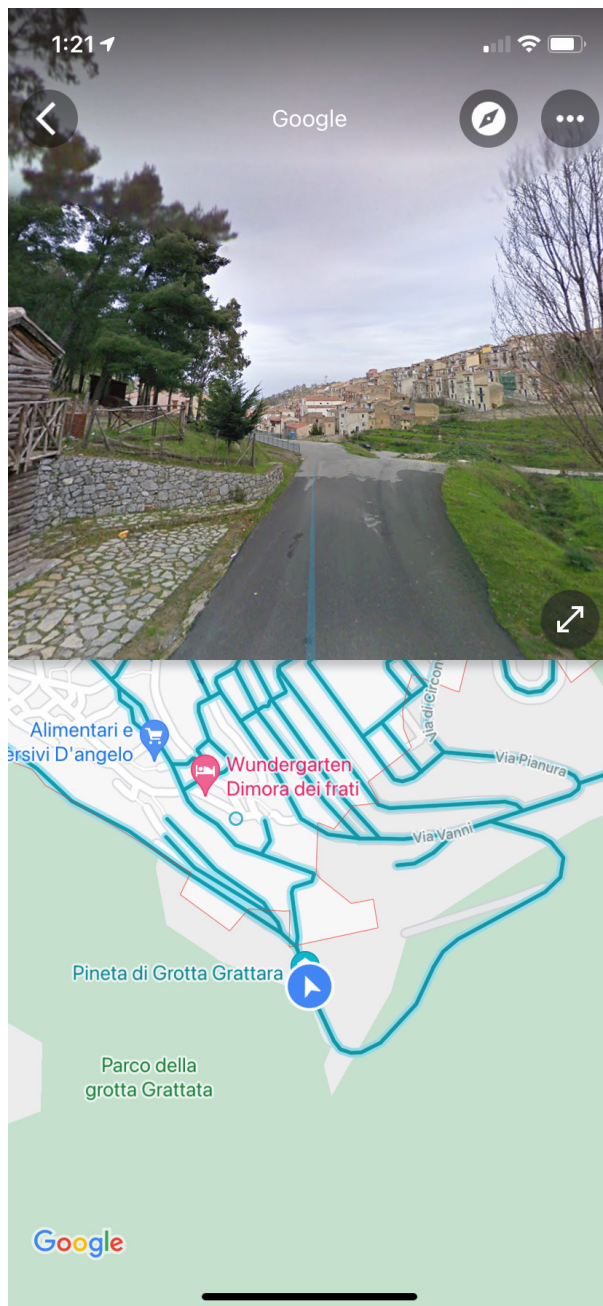
Stay on this road.

Take Via Parisea up the incline to the left.



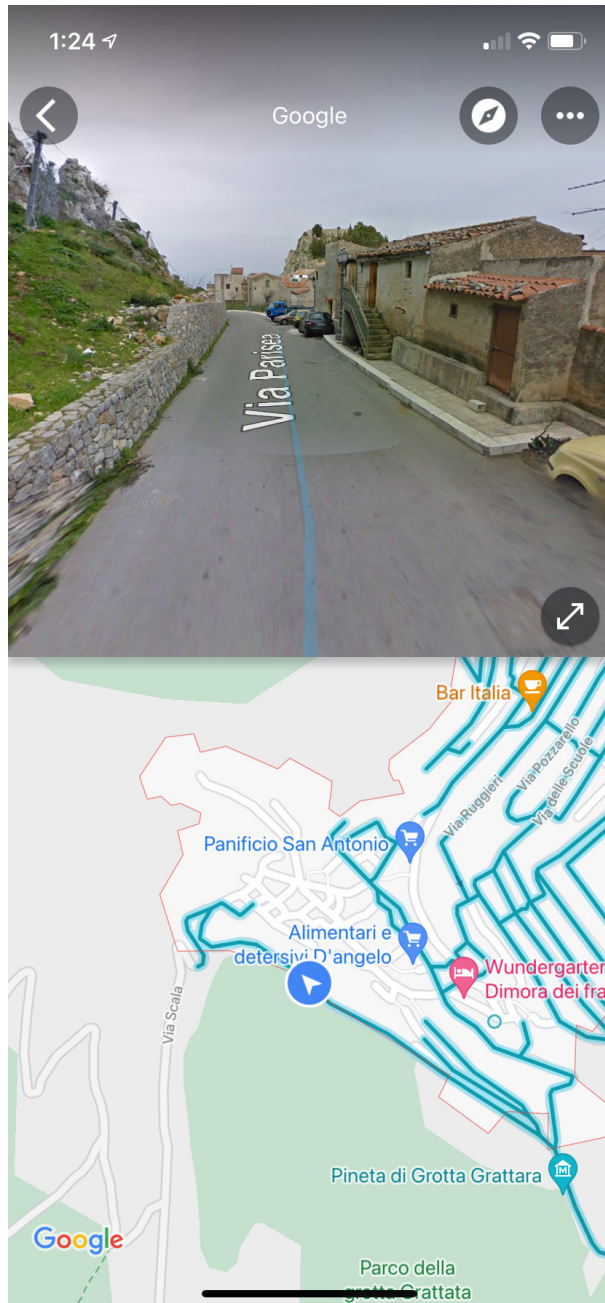
Via Parisea will take you directly into Piazza Scala. Stay straight.

Note the nice lamp posts.



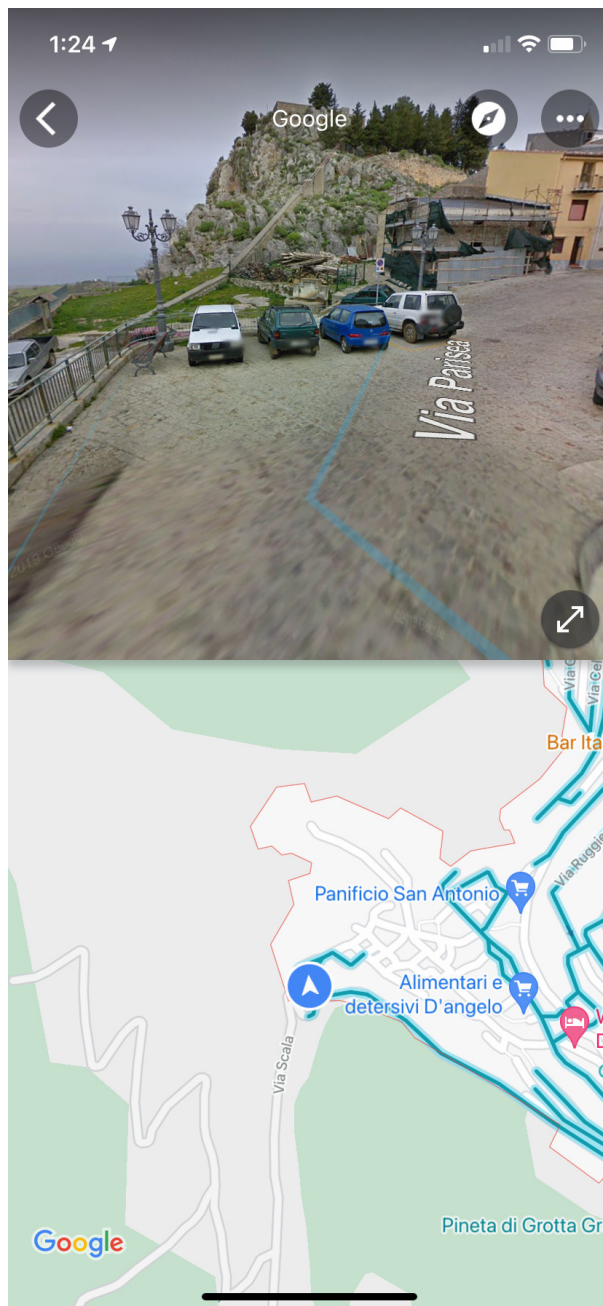
Continue to follow Via Parisea.



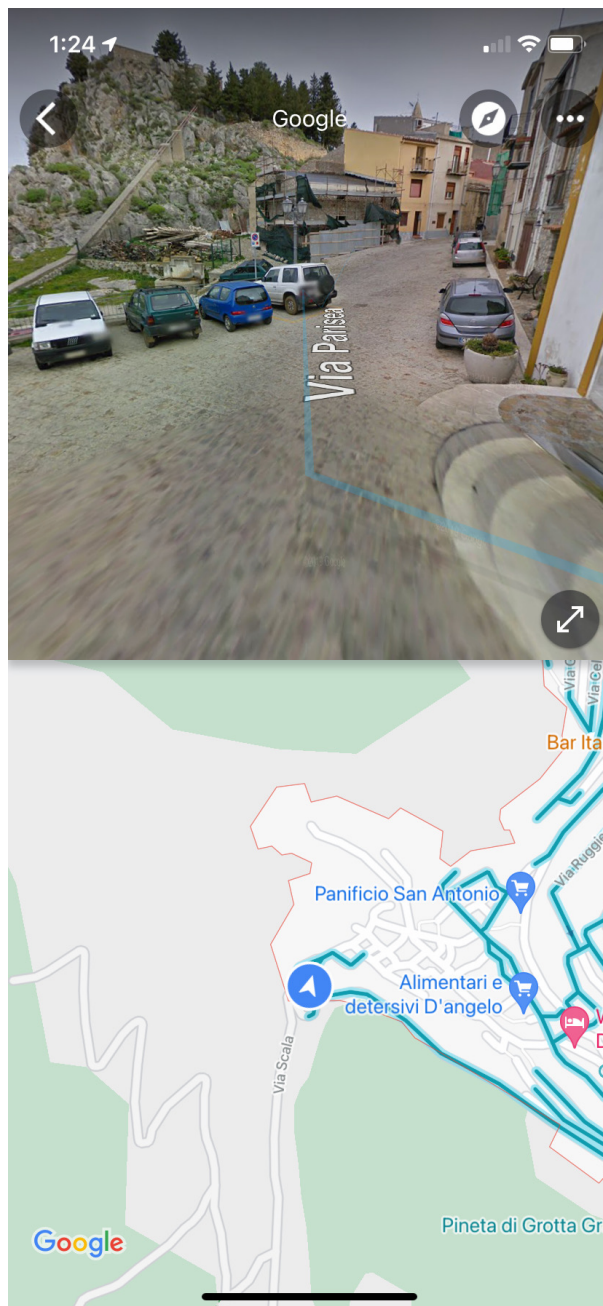
Follow Via Parisea around the curve into Piazza Scala.
