- Can occur in any part of the workplace whether inside or outside
- May result in serious injuries
- Significant cost to both the worker and employer



SLIPS: Occurs when there is too little friction or traction between your feet and the walking surface, and you lose your balance



TRIPS: Occurs when you are too far off your center of balance due to catching your foot on something.



FALLS: Occurs when you move downwards, typically rapidly and freely without control, from a higher to lower level

Common Causes...

SLIPS:

- Wet or oily surfaces
- Occasional spills
- Weather hazards
- Loose, unanchored mats
- Flooring or other walking surfaces that do not have same degree of traction in all areas

- Obstructed view
- Poor lighting
- Clutter in your walking way
- Wrinkled mats
- Uncovered cables
- Uneven walking surfaces

FALLS: Falls can be a result of <u>both slips and trips</u>. But additionally can occur when laddars or stepping stools are not maintained properly

Prevention...

- Clean up spills immediately
- Wear proper shoes (specifically, non-slip shoes)
- Place wet floor signs
- Use mats in areas prone to water or grease spills
- Announce "corner" when coming around a blind corner
- Keep items secure, to reduce obstructions in walkway





Accident Investigations

- Sunday (3/4) at Multnomah Village -- Sprain of the Finger
- **Cause:** Tried to catch falling container and crushed finger between safe and container
- How could this be prevented? Let everything fall to the ground
- **Recommendations:** Although it's a reflex to catch something when falling, just let the items fall to the ground to prevent injury. Just like you never catch a knife when it is falling.
