PLEIN AIR CORNER I'm always looking for ways to improve my art. One source that I've found helpful is *Art School Love* with Eric Rhoads on YouTube. He does a live show every day at 12 noon; you

can find all the previous episodes on YouTube. He brings on nationally acclaimed artists in all mediums to give a short demo or explain a particular technique. You don't need to sign up or register, just go onto YouTube. He is also the publisher of *Plein Air Magazine* and *Fine Art Connoisseur*.

His company Streamline Publishing produces art videos and holds multiple art events throughout the year. I recently attended the publisher's "Invitational Winter Escape 2025" in St. Augustine, FL. It was a 7-day immersive plein air event. They had arranged for us to paint in areas of the city where artists usually were not allowed to paint. Each day we went to a different location around the area, including the Castillo de San Marco fort, Fountain of Youth, Anastasia State Park, and Flagler College. Our lodging and meals were provided for, so we could just enjoy painting and meeting other plein air painters.
