We will be doing basic painting and also paint-mixing, while creating a gorgeous work of your own art. A workshop on creating vibrant, colorful paintings with gouache!

SUPPLY LIST

As this is a gouache workshop, I will really appreciate you bring gouache paints. I like using Winsor & Newton brand. A lot can be done with just the basic Winsor & Newton Designers Gouache Primary Set of 6 and an extra tube of titanium white.

A notebook for notes and ideas. Pencils and pens for drawing.

Cold press watercolor 140lb paper pad. Your choice of size (9x12 or 6x8)

Roll of ¼" white artist tape preferred or just blue tape is fine.

We will be doing small works.

Set of watercolor brushes. Get the affordable variety bag of synthetic brushes if you don't have any. Flats, rounds of varying sizes.

Watercolor mixing tray with ample mixing space (Butcher Tray is advisable and not the flower tray)

A water cup

Guideline to colors if you want to buy separate tubes

- ☐ Permanent white
- ☐ primary or cad yellow
- ☐ yellow ochre
- ☐ marigold yellow or cad orange med
- ☐ burnt sienna
- ☐ cad red
- ☐ alizarine crimson or quinacridone magenta
- ☐ spectrum violet
- ☐ ultramarine blue
- ☐ cerulean blue
- ☐ oxides of chromium green
- ☐ burnt umber.

Please don't buy acrylic gouache

Easel – your choice (table or standing) else you can do flat on table.

Paper towels or painting rags
