Supply List

Oil paints -- Bring the oil paint that you use.

I WILL HAVE SOME OIL PAINTS FOR YOUR USE. If this is your first time with oils - buying the top of the line brand is not necessary. It is good to have a warm and a cool of each color.

These are the colors that I use:

- Titanium White
 - Cad. Yellow
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Cad. Orange
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Cad Red
 - Dioxine Purple
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Sap Green
 - Permanent Green
 - Light Asphaltum (Gamblin)
 - Transparent Red Oxide/Earth Red
 - Brushes - you won't really use them but bring a few if you have them.
 - Old brushes!
 - Latex Gloves
 - Blue Painters tape
 - 1 Roll of Paper towels
 - Plastic or metal palette knives
 - Gessoed panels - I prefer DaVinci pro medium textured gesso panels (do not use ultra smooth) need some tooth! Bring at least 2 - 3 panels. No larger than 16 x 20 or 12 x 24.
