

Timmy the Turtle - Glass Enamel Painting

This introductory class will show you how to use enamel paint on glass. The paint is a powder that is mixed with Medium to become a liquid form that you can then apply to glass. You will start out using a toothpick to paint Timmy. Yes a toothpick. From there you can progress to a paintbrush.

The instructor will provide a beginner's kit for \$72 which has everything you need to create your turtle, with a few exceptions listed below.

The beginner's kit will include:

- 9 colors of enamel glass paint
- a brush
- medium
- pods to mix paint.
- 8" x 10" piece of glass for painting.
- Thinfire paper for fusing.
- One kiln firing.

YOU will need to bring:

- Toothpicks
- Metal Mixing spatula (see note below)
- A Plastic blending palette (see note below)
- Additional paintbrushes if you wish, but they should not have been used with other products.
