

SUPPLY LIST FOR COLDWAX WORKSHOP

- ☐ **Reference photo-** A simple landscape or seascape is a great way to begin painting with cold wax. I will also bring samples of my work to be referenced.
- ☐ **Acrylic paints-** Bring your favorites. Tube paints only. Be sure to include colors to achieve your reference photo paintings. (no craft paints please) craft paints do not mix well with the cold wax.
- ☐ **Flexible smooth paint/resin spreaders.** (asst. sizes) be sure they are flexible...rigid spreaders for bondo etc. do not work well.
(These are available on amazon and also at Hobby Lobby)
- ☐ **Palette knives** - bring as many sizes as you have. I will talk about each and the effects you will achieve by using them.
- ☐ **Brushes** - small to medium flat & angle edge and small detail brushes
- ☐ **Silicone paint brushes** (Flat painting tool) 1in & 2in. (inexpensive - also available on amazon and at Hobby Lobby)
- ☐ **Large Ziplock bag** for dirty palette knives after use
- ☐ **Gloves** if wanted
- ☐ **Paper towels**
- ☐ **Water container**
- ☐ **Ruler**
- ☐ **Disposable paper palette** or parchment paper
- ☐ Canvas-*** I will be providing 8x8 pre-prepped canvases for the sake of time.
- ☐ Cold wax - this medium will be provided by me also
