Code of conduct for parents/guardians and spectators

Parents, Carers and Guardians are welcomed and actively encouraged to view training sessions and encourage all the children involved.

- · Publicly accept officials / coaches judgement

- Use appropriate language and behaviour at all times
- · Remember children are individuals and must be respected for that

NB totally unacceptable is the use of offensive language, physical force, any intimidating behaviour or anything in relation to disability, race, age, culture, ability, gender, religion or sexual persuasion that may offend another
