### Code of conduct and behaviour policy for young people taking part in JDC activities

As a young person engaged in sporting activities I recognise that I should set a good example for myself and others and **I will** :

- have fun

- use equipment that is available for the purpose it is designed for
- listen carefully to instructions from the coaching staff
- act fairly and not to cheat at any point
- show good sportsmanship to my fellow competitors and team members
- actively encourage others in the group to do well and congratulate those who achieve
- arrive on time and come prepared for the activities

#### **I will not:**

- have fun at the expense of effecting the safety of others
- bully other participants either personally or part of a group
- put any of my fellow participants in danger of any description
- interrupt the coaching staff or put anyone off from completing an activity
- swear or verbally assault another person
- use any physical force to hurt or intimidate another person
- laugh at or embarrass other participants
- argue with any coach or official
- smoke, consume alcohol or non prescriptive drugs of any kind

Unacceptable behaviour by children,

- disrupting sessions / activities
- using inappropriate language
- abusing or disrespecting others
- stealing or deliberately damaging others participants belongings
- physical , emotional , or verbally abusing another
- discriminatory remarks on race, gender, ability , illness, or disability
- sexually unwanted comments to anyone
- use of electronic mediums to do any of the above, texting, emails, social media etc
