COMMUNION LITURGY

MEANING OF THE SACRAMENT

Beloved in the Lord Jesus, the meal which we are about to celebrate is a feast of remembrance, communion, and hope. We come to remember that Jesus was sent into the world to assume our flesh and blood, to become God with us, that we might be redeemed. We come to have communion with this same Christ who has promised to be with us even to the end of the world. We come in hope, believing that this bread and this cup are a pledge and a foretaste of a new heaven and a new earth, where we shall behold God. Jesus said, I was hungry and you gave me food; I was thirsty and you gave me drink. Here is the bread of life given for us; Iet all who hunger come and eat. Here is the fruit of the vine, poured out for us; Iet all who thirst come and drink.

COMMUNION PRAYER

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.** Lift up your hearts! **We lift them up to the Lord.** Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **It is right to give our thanks and praise!**

Holy and right it is to give you thanks and praise at all times and in all places, O God our Creator.
