Division & Class Entry Rules

**** Open/Green horse cross poles is for green horses only**

- **Each rider and horse may only compete in two Divisions**
- **A horse may be entered in a maximum of two competitive Divisions (not including Poles classes or cross poles).**
- **Poles and cross poles classes do not count toward a horse's Division limit and may be used freely.**

As this is a small community show, volunteer participation is essential to keeping costs down and ensuring a smooth event for everyone.

Horse Show Policies

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash on the show grounds please. And must not enter the warm-up or ingate area. Please avoid walking through the barns with your dog.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Must be worn at all sanctioned competitions. All competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear must meet the ASTM standards and display the SEI seal. The British standard is also acceptable. Any rider violating this rule at any time will be immediately prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

LUNGING: Lunging is to be done in the second arena - ONLY before 8am all lunging horses must be out of warm up ring by 8am.

TACK & EQUIPMENT: Please ensure your tack and equipment follow the HCBC hunter jumper protocol and rules.

Jackets & Show attire - must be worn unless judge excuses for the day

NUMBERS: Must be worn and visible at all times when mounted.

SHOWING FROM TRAILER: Must park in designated area. Responsible for complete cleanup of manure, hay and garbage.

ENTRIES:

Entries close OCTOBER 1st . Please ensure your entries are complete and legible and in by this date to avoid a late fee or risk not being accepted at all!

Fees: \$70/Division \$30/class

Entries payable by e- transfer. Payment is due by the closing date or will be considered a late entry and charged accordingly. A parent or legal guardian must sign the entry for a junior exhibitor and the junior's birthdate must be given. Rider/Horse name must be in message to ensure payment assigned to correct entry. Email to payments@cowichanhorses.ca. Scanned copies of entry form with e-transfer. Please use "horse" as password for e-transfer.

Junior: Minimum Age 6yrs as of the date of the competition until the end of the calendar year they turn 18. All Junior Riders must be supervised in the warm-up ring and collecting area by an experienced Adult with minimum HCBC membership. Amateur: Over 18

Open: not limited by age or amateur status. Coaches and Trainers must show at open level.

SCRATCHES: PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW – Exhibitors canceling after closing date shall forfeit their entry fees except in the case of disability of entry. Entries will be refunded only upon the presentation to the show secretary a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW. Stabling cannot be returned unless we are able to rebook the stall in time. Your help with this would be appreciated.

STABLING: Stabling is limited so please enter early. **Bring your own wheelbarrow and forks as there is limited tools.** Please indicate stabling on your entry form. If horses are staying overnight in the stalls an declared responsible adult. The exhibition grounds lock the gate in the evening for safety.

Medal Equitation: Over fences class with additional tests incorporated into the course, possibly including skinny jump, trot jump, counter canter, hand gallop. The flat class for divisions 1 & 2 may include a short gymnastics phase as well as a simple flat test for each exhibitor.

Jumper Equitation: Similar to Medal but usually with only one or two additional tests. Flat Class will be an individual flat test for each exhibitor. All classes to be judged on rider position and effectiveness. Any jumping faults incurred by the horse/pony will be taken into consideration by the judge if deemed appropriate. Classes 1,2,11,12,13,14 trotting will not be penalized.

Prizes & Awards

CHAMPION & RESERVE: Division Championship and Reserve Division Championship to receive rosettes upon the completion of each division. All classes in a division must be entered to be eligible for championship (over fences and flat). Ribbons to 6th place for each individual class. Points: 1st 7, 2nd.5, 3rd.4, 4th 3, 5th 2, 6th 1.
