IMT Insurance Company retained this law firm to defend you in the above-captioned matter which arises out of a fence dispute which occurred in August 2011, at or near your home located at 137 James Drive, Macomb, Illinois. We held off originally reaching out to both of you since we were waiting for the reservation of rights letter that was sent out by the company. Our defense is under a reservation of rights. We are in touch with your personal counsel in the mean time.

Please note that while IMT is reserving its rights as to indemnity, it is honoring an obligation to defend under the policy of insurance. To that end, it retained our firm to defend you both and control that defense. Please note that we are being paid exclusively by IMT. IMT is coming forward to pay all defense fees, costs, expenses and disbursements.

Mr. Skinner,

During our phone conversation in October, you told me that after you filed the motion to dismiss case 14-CH-19, you were scheduled to appear in court on November 25 to hear the judge decision on that motion. When I called you to know the court decision a week ago, you also told me that the judge has decided to dismiss the case and has given 30 days menth to the plaintiff to file a new complaint "following Illinois rules". I then requested a copy of the court decision and you promised to send it the same day.

Today December 16, I received your letter dated December 12, which contains no copy of the court decision you promised to send me. Instead of a copy of the court decision, you reported a supposed discussion you have had with the plaintiffs' attorney. So far, I have not made a demand for any discussion with the "plaintiffs". The only legal action I was aware of is the motion to dismiss which was directed to the McDonough County Court. My spouse and I have never demanded the mercy of the "plaintiffs". We are simply requesting a hard copy of the official court decision you said you received on November 25, 2014, because the e-mail attachment you claimed is the court decision is inaccessible.

As for you advice regarding attorneys from Chicago area selected by the insurance company for us, I have been very clear from the beginning that we do not need the service of any pseudo attorney hired by any insurance company to defend us. At least, we should have the right to choose the attorney we deem suitable to represent us and the appropriate time for a legal response to this masquerade.

A legal firm outside Illinois has proposed to handle the countersuing and any other complaint

without requesting any contingency fee.

We are not asking you to represent us any further in the pursuit of this matter. The sole document we are awaiting from you is the court decision you previously acknowledged that you received on November 25, 2014.
