WHAT AND HOW

Change happens. It is either the change you want, or the change you were hoping would not happen. Let's Figure Out the right change. Together.

Begin- as individuals

We create change with activities, such as collaborative art. These level the playing field and help participants get to know each other, quickly.

Become-friends

We build relationships along with empathy and understanding of each other. This means the event's conversations move quickly, with honesty and creativity. Then we **Figure It Out** together in Solution Circles and deep conversations. Participants often develop longlasting friendships during Figure It Out.

Believe-the Outcomes

Your group will have an understanding of how to affect change, together. There will be three to five Power Plans, a group Resolution Statement, and hope for tomorrow.
