

Get Ready for the October Ride!!

When: Thursday, October 15, 2026. Please be ready to ride out at **10:00am sharp**

Where: Groom Creek in Prescott, across the street from the Groom Creek Horse Camp

The ride will be about 2.5-3 hours long, so please make sure your horse is adequately conditioned and shod. There is no charge for this ride as you will need to pack your own lunch and beverages. Also, please bring a chair for lunch, water for your horse and a manure fork for clean-up. Anyone wanting to get there the day before and stay over, please contact Groom Creek Horse Camp for reservations for your trailer and a stall for your horse.

Horse Rentals: Gibb will be providing rentals for this ride **IF** he gets at least 6 rentals. Contact him directly BEFORE OCTOBER 12TH at 435-640-2748. He prefers texts over calls. In case of questionable weather, you must contact Gibb directly to cancel.

In case of inclement weather with ride cancellation, you will be notified the evening before and there will be no group lunch option.

DIRECTIONS:

FROM WICKENBURG - Head north on **US-93 N / AZ-89 N** and **Continue on AZ-89 N**: Follow AZ-89 N for roughly 55 miles as it winds north toward Prescott, passing through Congress and Yarnell. **Enter Prescott:** As you approach central Prescott, continue onto **AZ-89 N / S Montezuma St** or transition toward **E Gurley St**. **Turn onto Senator Highway:** Turn right onto **E Gurley St**, then take a right onto **S Mt Vernon St**, which becomes **Senator Highway** (County Road 56 / Forest Road 52) heading south. **Arrive at the Camp:** Follow Senator Highway south for about 7.2 miles past downtown Prescott and through the Groom Creek community. Look for [Groom Creek Horse Camp](#) (address: 5101 S Senator Hwy) on your right BUT we will be staging across the street – LOOK FOR THE LADY SIGNS.

FROM PHOENIX - Take **I-17 North** from Phoenix for about 61.8 miles. Take **exit 262** toward Cordes Junction/Prescott to merge onto **State Route 69 West**. Follow State Route 69 West for 33.8 miles toward Prescott. At the highway split, take the ramp for **Route 89 South** (East Gurley Street) and follow it for about 0.8 miles. Turn left onto **Mt. Vernon Street** (Senator Highway / County Road #56). Continue south on Senator Highway for about 7.2 miles. LOOK FOR THE LADY SIGNS, across the street from the Horse Camp.
